

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

is made the day of 2008

between

(1) **OXFORD BROOKES UNIVERSITY**, a UK higher education institution incorporated under statute, of Gipsy Lane, Headington, Oxford, UK OX3 0BP ("OBU") acting by its Vice-Chancellor, Professor Janet Beer

and

(2) **JAYPEE INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY UNIVERSITY**, a university established in **India**, of A-10, Sector-62, Noida - 201307 ("JIIT") acting by its Vice Chancellor, Professor J.P.Gupta

together called "the Parties"

Whereas:

- A The Parties are both reputable providers of higher education
- B The Parties wish to explore the potential for the mutual enhancement of their relationship including by discussion and planning related to the areas of joint working described below

It is understood that:


1. The Parties acknowledge each other's integrity, discretion and standing in respect of the students, academic matters and proper processes relating to their individual institutions
2. The Parties confirm their willingness to co-operate as educational institutions and wish to declare their current intention to develop joint working with a view to planning specific areas of collaborative activity
3. The Parties expect to conduct initial discussion through Professor John Raftery, Pro Vice-Chancellor (External) on behalf of OBU and Professor J.P. Gupta on behalf of JIIT whilst acknowledging that all formal negotiations and proposals relating to specific students and specific programmes must be conducted subject to the Parties' own proper procedures and approvals including by senior management
4. The Parties wish to record that they expect to explore and progress collaborative activity including without limitation in the area of a jointly-delivered course of study leading to OBU's awards of MSc's in Biotechnology with Business and Telecommunications Electronics
5. This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain valid for a period of two (2) years from the date on which it is made. The Memorandum of

Understanding may be extended, subject to review, by mutual agreement of the Parties

6. Either Party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding after giving the other party three (3) months' written notice of its intention to do so
7. Neither Party may use the name or logo of the other Party without the prior written consent of that other Party and neither Party shall represent to any third Party that the Parties have a legal relationship until there is a signed contract between the Parties in place
8. This Memorandum of Understanding is neither intended to place legally binding obligations on either party nor to give either party any authority to act on behalf of or to commit any expenditure by the other party
9. The Parties remain at liberty to discuss collaborative activity with any third party


