## Our Policy for Online Payment Gateway

### Privacy Policy

- The University is committed to protecting personally-identifiable information that we handle in the course of providing our authentication-related services ("Personal Information"). This Privacy Policy describes our information-handling practices. Our policy is simple: We collect no personal information about you unless you choose to provide that information to us. We do not give, share, sell, or transfer any personal information to a third party.

- **INFORMATION COLLECTION & USE**

University is the sole owner of the Personal Information collected through our Web Sites or in connection with the Services. *Non-personal Information We Record*

- If you do nothing during your visit but browse through the website, read pages, or download information, our website's operating system will automatically record some general information about your visit.

- During your visit, our web operating system will record:

1. The **Internet domain** for your Internet service, such as "abc.com" or " any such domain if you use a private Internet access account, or "yourcollege.edu" or "your college .ac if you connect from a college or university domain.
2. The **type of browser** (such as "Internet Explorer X") that you are using.
3. The **type of operating system** that you use (such as Linux, Unix, or Windows).
4. The **date and time** you visit our site, and the **web pages that you visit** on our site.
5. The address of the **previous website** you were visiting, if you linked to us from another website.

We may use this information for statistical analysis, to help us make our site more useful to visitors. This tracking system does not record information about individuals.

- **Cookies**

On certain IIIT University web pages, we use "cookies" to help you use our websites interactively.

The cookies on JIIT University web pages do not collect information about you, but only about your browser "session." The cookie makes it easier for you to use the dynamic features of these web pages, without having to provide the same information again as you move from one page to another.

To protect your privacy, be sure to close your browser completely after you have finished conducting business with a website that uses cookies. If you are concerned about the potential use of information gathered from your computer by cookies, you can set your browser to prompt you before it accepts a cookie. Most Internet browsers have settings that let you identify and/or reject cookies.

➤ **Information from E-mail You Send to Us**

If you decide to send us an electronic mail message (e-mail), the message will usually contain your return e-mail address. If you include personally-identifying information in your e-mail because you want us to address issues specific to your situation, we may use that information in responding to your request. Also, e-mail is not necessarily secure against interception. Please send only information necessary to help us process your request.

➤ **Information Collected from Interactive Forms**

On some of our web pages we offer interactive forms that let you voluntarily submit personal information (such as your e-mail address, name, or organization). This occurs when you are registering for online counseling, various tests, quizzes, seminars, conferences registration, workshops, or training sessions offered by JIIT University, downloading admission forms from JIIT University. In those cases, all submitted information is used only for the purposes for which it is intended and is not made available to any third party.

➤ **Links to Other Sites**

Our policy discloses the privacy practices for the JIIT University website. But JIIT provides links to other websites. When you leave the JIIT website ([www.jiit.ac.in](http://www.jiit.ac.in)), you will be going to sites that are beyond our control. These other sites may send their own cookies to users, collect data, or solicit personal information. The privacy policies and procedures described here for JIIT do not apply to any external links. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of any site you link to from ours, especially if you share any personal information. Be informed. You are the person best qualified to protect your own privacy.

➤ **SECURITY**

We consider the protection of all personal information we receive from our Web Site visitors, Subscribers, Relying Parties, and Certificate Holders as a core responsibility. We have security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse, and alteration of Personal Information. As with any transmission over the Internet, however, there is always some element of risk involved in sending personal information. In order to try to minimize this risk, we encrypt information that you submit to us electronically when submitting requests or ordering certificates.

We implement data security safeguards based upon generally accepted industry standards to protect your Personal Information from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, alteration, or loss. Nonetheless, no data security techniques are 100% effective, and we cannot guarantee its security.

2. Fee details are as follows:
