

How to reach IIIT, Noida

The easiest way to go to Noida by public transport is to take the Delhi Metro or the Buses of DTC (Delhi Transport Corporation), which has numerous stops around the city.

Air: Noida is connected well connected to Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI), Delhi. Many domestic flights arrive at Terminal 3 (T3). If you arrive at T3, first look for a volunteer with NCSSI-9 placard (near gate number 5). In case no such specific arrangement is made for you or for some reason the volunteer can not be located then please use alternative mode of transports.

1. Cabs can be hired from inside the terminals to Sector-62 Noida.

2. Once you come out from Terminal 3 you will see a set of pillars. Adjacent to Pillar number 18 there exist a city Bus counter of DTC. From there you can avail a red colored air-conditioned low floor Bus to Jaipuria Mall, Indirapuram. The bus goes directly to sector-62, Noida where IIIT is located. One should get down at Police Chowki, Sector - 62. The fare of the bus is Rs. 107.

If your flight does not arrive at T3 then from exit gate walk towards left for about 50 m and you will find a DTC bus pickup point. The red DTC bus coming from T3 will pick passengers from this point too for Jaipuria Mall, Indirapuram. Get down at sec-62 Police Chowki (Model Town Police Chowki)

3. Radio Taxi can be booked in advance by dialing 011-47774777

Metro: The station closest to the campus is NOIDA CITY CENTER. Once you get down from the metro, take the left exit (facing the engine). Shared autos and reserved autos are available there. You have to book one for IIIT, Sector-62. Shared auto fare is Rs. 10 per person and a reserved auto will cost you Rs. 50 to Rs. 60.

Road Service: The campus is located on the National Highway 24, near the 12th milestone from Delhi. However, there are two routes to get to Noida from Delhi. The DND Flyway toll bridge connects Noida to Delhi and is a pleasure to drive.

The other one is the National Highway 24 from Indraprastha Park through the CWG village to NOIDA.

Here is some more information for driving:

Railway: The New Delhi Railway Station and the Old Delhi railway station connect Noida to the Indian railway network. Cabs, Autos can be hired just outside the railway stations.

Those who are staying in the Abhay Palace Hotel, Ghaziabad can reach the campus by road.

You can also get down at Ghaziabad station and take the exit towards Vijay Nagar. Campus is very close from there. A reserved auto will cost about 80-100 Rs.

A cab from New Delhi station will cost you about Rs 350 to Abhay palace Hotel and Rs. 400 to the institute.

From Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station, come out of the station on opposite side (exit towards increasing number of plate form). You may find auto, taxi, radio taxi from there to sector-62, Noida. It takes about 30-35 minutes to reach to JIIT from here in no rush hour. Taxi fare will be around Rs. 350. Tell the vehicle to take you towards NH24. Institute is located opposite to Shipra Mall.
