Through every season, a vibrant hue, Festivals of art and science ensue, Where minds collide and cultures blend, In unity, JIIT's spirits ascend.


A name to remember, echoing through time, A legacy of brilliance that continues to climb, In the world of technology, it shines bright, A constellation that guides us through the night.






# Directorate of Research, Innovation and Development



## Research, Innovation, Development, and Entrepreneurship (RIDE)



The establishment of the RIDE (Research, Innovation, Development, and Entrepreneurship) Innovation Hub at JIIT serves as a pivotal platform for both students and faculty members to engage in incubation activities. By fostering a culture of innovation and risk-taking, the RIDE Innovation Hub plays a crucial role in shaping the future of JIIT and the broader entrepreneurial ecosystem. It catalyzes the development of new products, services, and technologies with the potential to significantly impact society. Operating as a registered legal entity with clearly defined incubation objectives, the hub occupies a 15,000-square-foot space. Within this space, it offers various amenities such as start-up cubicles, collaboration areas, innovation laboratories, and other essential facilities tailored for start-up ventures, pre-start-ups, and innovation projects. RIDE provides comprehensive support to incubatees, including legal, business, and technical mentorship to assist them in achieving their technical and business goals effectively. The below image depicts the floor plan of the innovation hub (RIDE).

Currently, two start-ups and fourteen pre-start-ups are operating under RIDE. Apart from students' start-ups and pre-start-ups, the faculty of JIIT are also promoted for innovation in RIDE. The objective of the faculty innovation project scheme is similar to Student Pre-Start-up projects, but these projects are expected to have direct and leading involvement of the faculty. In the first phase, six faculty innovation projects have been approved and seed funds provided. In the second phase, it is expected to approve approximately 60-70 projects.

Moreover, under the Centre of Excellence Scheme, faculty teams from different departments are encouraged to work together to achieve well-defined deliverables. The central objective of this scheme is to create and enhance a research and innovation ecosystem in JIIT. At present, three Centers of Excellence have been formed: Artificial Intelligence for Education, UAV and electronic border security, and Bio-Technology solutions for soil and water remediation. Under these Centers of Excellence, 12 faculty projects are running, supported by RIDE with necessary funding. RIDE is also fostering research collaboration with other organizations. Recently, the faculty of JIIT initiated work on nine different projects in collaboration with Jaypee Hospital, Noida.



## i-Drone study for transporting blood bags-first of its kind in India:

The research teams from the Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, Noida (JIIT), Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC), New Delhi, and Government Institute of Medical Sciences (GIMS), Greater Noida conducted a project to check for the feasibility and validation of using drones for transferring blood bags and blood components as compared to conventional transportation methods (via road). This ICMR-funded project was being conducted under the guidance of the project investigators, Prof. Pammi Gauba and Prof Shweta Dang (JIIT), Prof. Anita Nangia and Prof. Sangeeta Pahuja from LHMC, Prof. Rambha Pathak and Prof. Shalini Bahadur from GIMS. The Chief Guest, Dr. Rajiv Bahl, Director General, ICMR, graced the occasion with his presence at JIIT NOIDA campus.









An MoU was signed between Bobble AI and Machine Leaning lab of ECE department of Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida on 26.07.2023. 





### Feb 02, 2023




## Mind and Meditation February 14, 2023






# Transforming Land Governance through Digitization: Prospects & Challenges April 08, 2023














## Nostalgía & Scríbble February 03, 2023








#### Fire Safety Drill March 07, 2023
