NOTIFICATION

Whereas "Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT)", Noida (Uttar Pradesh), was declared as a 'deemed-to-be-university', under *De Novo* category' under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 vide this Ministry's notification of even number dated the 1st November, 2004 subject to certain conditions that included a review after three years;

- 2. And whereas, the UGC has reviewed the functioning of the "JIIT", Noida through an Expert Committee constituted for this purpose;
- 3. And, whereas, on the basis of the report of the Expert Committee, the UGC vide its communication No.F.6-8/2004 (CPP-I) dated the 25th February, 2008 have recommended continuation of the status of 'Deemed-to-be-University' to "JIIT", Noida, subject to a further review after five years;
- 1. Now, therefore, the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, and on the advice of the UGC in the matter, do hereby accord approval to the continuance of "Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida, as a deemed-to-be-university for the purpose of the aforesaid Act, under *de novo* category, for a further period of five years, strictly in terms of this Ministry's notification of even number dated the 1st November, 2004, subject to the following conditions that:

- (i) the progress and performance of the JIIT shall be reviewed by the UGC with the help of an Expert Committee after a period of five years and that the status of 'deemed-tobe-university' conferred on the JIIT, Noida, shall be confirmed on the basis of the report of the said Expert Review Committee and recommendation of the UGC thereon;
- (ii) the JIIT should immediately revise the Memorandum of Association (MoA) / Rules in line and in accordance with the model MoA/Rules prescribed by the UGC and get the approved MoA/Rules duly registered;
- (iii) the JIIT Society should, as per the advice of the UGC, submit an undertaking, on stamp paper, from the Jaiprakash Sewa Sansthan (JSS) Trust, New Delhi that the land subleased by the NOIDA will be allowed to be in possession of JIIT, Noida, permanently; and,
- (iv) the JIIT should adhere to the norms and guidelines prescribed by the UGC and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), from time to time, as are applicable to the institutions declared as deemed-to-be-universities under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956.
- 5. The declaration made in para 4 above shall be subject to further conditions that are mentioned at SI. No. 4 of the endorsement of this notification.
