Courses registration Sequence

- (a) Back log core courses starting from the first semester
- (b) Core subjects of the Odd semester subject to the maximum credit restriction.
- (c) HSS and Science Electives courses ONE from each basket minimum 4 choices may be prioritized.
- (d) Departmental electives. ONE per basket shall be allowed. However, student may choose all the courses from the basket duly prioritized.
- (e) Courses to improve the grades (on offer and subject to the credit limit and eligibility criteria requirement).
- (f) Those who wish to do some electives through MOOC's may follow the MOOC's regulation given in Academic System.

Special Instructions for Pre- Registration

- (a) Electives will be allotted based on CGPA criterion, where the number of seats are fixed for the electives.
- (b) Incase courses dropped/CGPA criteria not met, next course in order of priority within the basket shall be taken into consideration..
- (c) No changes shall be allowed on pre-registered courses.
- (d) Once the subjects are properly ticked the student shall have 2 options;
 - Click on save draft
 - Click on Freeze.
- (e) In case student presses on save draft then he/she shall be able to re-access the draft and modify it.
- (f) In case student presses freeze then the choices of subjects are frozen and treated as final.
- (g) In case student fails to freeze the choice it will automatically be locked on the last announced date.
- (h) Please retain a copy of frozen choices for future reference

Notes:

1. The Core Courses shall be registered through back-end except students with backlogs in core courses.

2. Elective Courses will be pre-registered by the students, as per Notice and guidelines to be issued.

3. Student should exercise the choice of subjects very carefully. No Changes shall be permitted unless approved by the HoDs of add/drop departments based on justifiable reasons.

- 4. The system shall allow the student to proceed with pre-registration in following priority only:
 - Priority-1 Backlog Courses on offer.
 - Priority-2 Core Courses of the semester.
 - **Priority-3** Compulsory electives like HSS.
 - Priority-4 Other electives on offer as per the curricula structure and baskets (one from each basket or as defined)
- 5. The students shall automatically be allocated the next elective course in order of priority exercised by them (in the basket) in case the elective chosen by them is dropped for the reason of under subscription.
- 6. No late pre-registration is allowed. All students must stick to the time schedule. Delay may lead to fine or not allowing the student to pre-register. Thus, student may not have choice of his / her own courses subsequently.

A maximum limit of candidates in each elective have been specified and the students may exercise their choice keeping this number in view. Electives will be allotted based on CGPA criterion, where the number of seats are fixed for the electives. Incase courses dropped/CGPA criteria not met, next course in order of priority within the basket shall be taken into consideration.
