The summary of students' satisfaction survey regarding teaching and learning reveals that more than $70 \%$ syllabus is covered in classes. Teachers thoroughly prepare for classes and are able to communicate well using ICT tools. Evaluation system is well established, transparent and fair. However, there is a need to strengthen the mentoring process and carry-
out more extracurricular activities for students. The institution requires to further enhance multiple opportunities to learn and grow by promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students.

## Summary of the Institutional facilities-based feedback:

The students were asked to rate institutional facilities on 6 parameters related to different departments. The ratings have been assigned scores from 5 to 1 as: Outstanding-5, Excellent4, Very good-3, Good-2, Fair-1. On the basis of rating given by students, the average ratings have been shown in the last column. As per survey, institutional facilities are between very good and excellent.
