



JIIT remains the first choice of individuals aspiring to make the difference in the world around them. Keeping up the tradition of academic rigour and societal relevance, we offer the B.A. Hons (Economics, Psychology & Sociology) program for 2012.

The structure and course content of the program is effectively designed which adds a special focus on the theory and its practice. It seeks to prepare students to pursue Post Graduate studies and also cater to the need of Industries, Social Organisations and Financial Institutions.

Salient Features of Study Program

- Choice of 3 year single honours degree
- Comprises 118 Credit courses
- Summer Training & Live Projects
- Special focus on Foreign languages
- Includes Software Applications
- Individual mentoring of students
- Emphasis on Interpersonal skills of students

The undergraduate program of study is intended to teach students to think critically and creatively, to conceptualize and solve problems, to analyze, reason and arrive at evidence-based conclusions, and to express themselves clearly and convincingly both in speech and in writing.

To achieve a balance of scope and depth of study, the UG programs will be characterized by the study of courses in foundational skills related to the humanities and social sciences, particularly in the earlier semesters, to promote a general understanding of these areas. This would be followed in later semesters by more intensive courses related to various academic disciplines in fulfilment of the requirements for majoring in an academic discipline or a combination of disciplines of study. In addition, the program of study will encompass a combination of courses designed to promote the acquisition of certain skills that students can bring to bear in a variety of learning and career/ professional situations.

Structure of the Program

The duration, courses of study and various streams available for majoring are listed here:

Duration & Credits

The BA Honours Program will comprise of 118 credits for a 3-year degree amounting to an average credit load of 21 (1st to 4th semester) and 17 (5th to 6th semester) of approximately 14 weeks of academic work.

Streams of BA Honours Available

Following options of study are available – Economics, Psychology and Sociology.

Program Components

For every student, BA Honours Program will have the following types of course offerings

1. Core Courses: These are the mandatory courses of Economic/Psychology/Sociology (82 credits).
2. Electives courses: Courses to chosen from the two categories:
 - I. Foundation Courses (08 credits)
 - II. Applied Courses (12 credits)
3. Subsidiary courses: These are courses which aim to provide students with flair of other streams of education to help them understand the society and human aspirations and behaviour. Such knowledge will help students understand and deal with the complexities of our society when they face the world on their own (16 credits).

Foundation & General Study Courses

Foundation and General Study Courses are common to all majors across various streams of study. These are designed to facilitate acquisition of certain foundational skills such as quantitative reasoning, language proficiency and analytical and communication skills that may be useful in a wide array of academic and non-academic endeavours. A few of the courses under this category have been prepared to provide students, coming from varying backgrounds, a basic understanding of the social sciences and an insight into the contemporary world and society. These courses will be offered in semesters 1 and 2.

Elective Courses

Elective courses relating to various disciplines and areas of study would enable students to gain an in-depth understanding of two or three academic disciplines and areas of study within the humanities and social sciences as well as to attain the pre-requisites for majoring in a stream of study. The elective courses will be on offer from semester 2 to 6 in the three year honours program.

The electives offered during the first year of the BA Honours program would ordinarily be introductory-level courses in the disciplinary areas. They would serve as introductory to these subject areas for those students who want a multi-disciplinary education involving the study of courses across two or three academic disciplines or areas of study. This would also be like a foundation in a disciplinary area to those students who would go onto major in that disciplinary area or area of study.

Student Assessment & Evaluation

The purpose of assessment and evaluation is to facilitate and promote learning with understanding. Students are expected to be regular in attending classes, workshops and other educational exercises. Work done by students during the teaching semester will count for more than the end-of-course examination. Grades will be given to students for performance in tests, classroom presentations, group discussions, fieldwork/project works, term papers and other exercises designed by teachers. Ability to work in a group or design an investigative project may be tested and evaluation may include peer assessment. Tutorials and mentoring will be important features of all programs.

Number of Seats

There are 30 seats in each program.

Fee Structure

Admission Procedure

- (i) Eligibility Criteria: Passed in 10+2 in any stream.
- (ii) How to apply: Application form can be submitted through any of the following means:

Further, a printout of the application should be taken, photo/DD attached (as applicable) and the application sent to the address given below.
