COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COLLABORATION AND PROFESSIONAL EXCHANGE

between

The Jaypee Education System, India

and

The Finnish Universities of Applied Sciences, Finland

The Jaypee Education System, India and the Finnish Universities of Applied Sciences, Finland with the objective of facilitating mutual friendship, academic exchange, research and educational co-operation between the two parties, hereby conclude this general agreement.

Activities of Mutual Co-operation

Mutual co-operation may include various activities:

- 1. Exchange of faculty members (teachers and staff) and researchers
- 2. Exchange of students
- 3. Joint research projects
- 4. Exchange of information and publications
- 5. Development of joint educational activities, joint and double degrees and courses
- 6. Other activities mutually agreed upon by the two parties

Terms of Validity and Termination

This agreement is written only in English language and it consists of 3 pages. The agreement becomes effective upon completion of signatures and it shall remain in force for a period of five years. The cooperation agreement may be extended by a written agreement of both sides.

Both sides may terminate the agreement by one year's written notice to the other side. In a situation of termination of the agreement the students and the faculty members must be provided to complete their exchange period/studies in a host institution.

Amendments

Amendments to this agreement may be made upon mutual decision of the two parties.

Financial Commitments and Obligations

This agreement shall not bind either party to any financial commitment. Students participating in the Exchange Program will not pay any tuition fees.

Concerning the faculty (teachers and staff) exchange the home institution covers all expenses including accommodation, meals, traveling costs and monthly salary.

Verification on Details of the General Agreement

The details of the co-operation are to be verified and determined as Annexes of the General Agreement for each academic year separately.
