All the members of Helping Others started up with a door-to-door campaign to educate everyone on the importance of waste segregation to contribute to the Swachh Bharat Mission. 3 departments were created for Biodegradable or Wet waste, Non-biodegradable or Dry waste and E-waste. Wet and dry waste segregation is practiced at home but for the electronic waste, special e-waste bins were set up below every two blocks. Pamphlets were distributed and notices were setup. Sweepers along with the maids were well informed and were taught for the same. In the morning the waste is collected by the sweeper in two separate bin carts. E-waste is disposed of separately by the individuals. Wet waste is handed off to the collector by the sweeper on a daily basis while dry and e-waste is handed off after every 15 days.

The medicine is then issued to them and the basic details of the medicine are entered into the computer system. 705 patients registered on February 29, 2020.

Other agencies have also been associated with providing medicines and laboratory services/surgeries/eye testing at very reasonable charges as per the requirement. Recently we have collaborated with Apollo which provides these people with free vaccination and medical equipment.

<p>30 artists from the well-known theatrical group "Sukhmanch" performed a street play in IIIT Sector-62 premises. The play focussed on the issues faced by the women in modern times, especially in India. The activity aimed to develop an understanding in the mind of viewers regarding the atrocities faced by women.</p> <p>On March 05, 2020 at 1'o o'clock, 30 theatre artists gathered in our institute's open stage and started playing <i>dafli</i> with their hands, it was the start of the calling process in order to gain the attention of students who had already started to come forward. The group then took to the corridors of the institute and roamed around getting the attention of people in the campus. When the group came back from their drill, people had gathered behind them and were following the group to the ground where the main play had to be performed.</p> <p>The group started from the story of eve-teasing where they portrayed how a few ill-minded men tried to pick-up girls by passing lewd comments. They further added an element of reality by making a group of people encircle them and sitting with their eyes closed. The artists went on to raise other issues such as the double standards of the Indian society towards men and women, on one hand the men of the house are allowed to come late and wear whatever they want while on the other hand there are restrictions on the timings a woman is allowed to be outside, what she wears and even after working at office she could be expected to do household chores. The group then acquainted us with practice of female foeticide killing wherein a man was shown forcing his wife to abort her unborn child just because the yet-to-be-born was a girl; that was her only mistake, a choice she, the child, didn't even had, and she had to suffer for it.</p> <p>Another part of the play that achieved great attention was the part containing acid-attacks. A young woman got engaged to a man, another man who was following her for</p>		

some time did not want her to marry someone else, he thought that the woman was very beautiful and would avenge his rejection by taking away her face. He clenched her hand and hurled acid over her face. The lady shrieked with pain and cried for help but it was of no use, the damage was done. Had someone had told him that women too have a choice in choosing their partners, that lady would not have suffered excruciating pain and blisters all over her face.

At last they concluded the act by telling the students about themselves, the general motive behind the act as discussed above, did the students like it and how relevant it was to them.
