On 30th January 2025, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Jaypee Institute of Information Technology organized a Road Safety Awareness Drive event as part of the **National Road Safety** campaign, supporting the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways' initiatives. The initiative aimed to foster responsible road-user behaviour, pedestrian safety, and community awareness about the importance of following traffic regulations.

The primary objective of the Road Safety Awareness Drive was to educate participants on safe driving practices and contribute towards reducing road accidents and fatalities. The initiative was in line with the National Service Scheme's commitment to community development and social responsibility. The drive aimed to engage students and local residents in promoting road safety through active participation in awareness-building activities.

The drive included the following key activities:

**Traffic Awareness Rally:** Volunteers carried placards and banners with messages like "Obey Traffic Rules, Save Lives" and "Helmet On, Life On," marching through the campus and adjacent streets to sensitize motorists and pedestrians.

**Interactive Sessions & Demonstrations:** Road safety experts conducted short talks on helmet and seat-belt use, the dangers of distracted and drunk driving, and pedestrian right-of-way. Practical demonstrations showcased proper helmet fitting, seat-belt fastening, and basic first-aid responses for accident victims.

**Resource Distribution:** Pamphlets and brochures detailing traffic signals, defensive driving tips, and emergency contact numbers were handed out to participants and passers-by, reinforcing key safety messages.

**Follow-Up Plan:** A committee was formed to monitor local road-safety behaviour over the following month. Participants were encouraged to report improvements in their own habits and share instances where they helped others adhere to safety norms.

The Road Safety Awareness Drive was a resounding success, not only in terms of the number of people reached but also in fostering a deeper sense of civic responsibility among participants. The event helped to strengthen the NSS Unit's mission to engage students in community service while promoting a safer, more conscientious road environment.

- A significant number of students, faculty, and staff members availed the services.
- The camp enabled participants to complete Aadhar-related tasks without the need to visit external centers.

On 11th April 2025, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Jaypee Institute of Information Technology organized a **Group Discussion Water Camp.** As part of its ongoing commitment to environmental awareness and student engagement. The event, organized by proactive student volunteers, focused on the pressing issue of water scarcity and emphasized the significance of sustainable water management. The discussion served as a platform for students to share insights, deliberate on challenges, and propose innovative solutions related to water conservation. The primary aim was to enhance awareness among the youth regarding water-related issues and inspire them to take responsible action in their daily lives.

### **Key Activities of the Group Discussion:**

- Water Conservation Strategies: Participants actively discussed various practical methods to conserve water, such as rainwater harvesting, fixing leakages, and using water-efficient appliances.
- Water Scarcity and Climate Change: Students examined how global climate change is intensifying water scarcity and explored region-specific impacts and potential mitigation techniques.

- Awareness & Behavioural Change: Emphasis was placed on the role of behavioural change in ensuring efficient water use. The importance of educating peers and the community was discussed at length.

Outcomes and Future Plans: The group discussion concluded with a shared commitment among students to initiate a Water Awareness Campaign across the campus. This would include poster drives, workshops on water-saving tips, and collaborations with NGOs focused on water sustainability. Furthermore, a proposal was made to conduct a Water Audit of the campus to identify wastage and recommend improvements. The Group Discussion on Water Camp proved to be an intellectually stimulating and socially relevant event. It not only heightened student awareness but also laid the groundwork for long-term water sustainability efforts within the institution.


