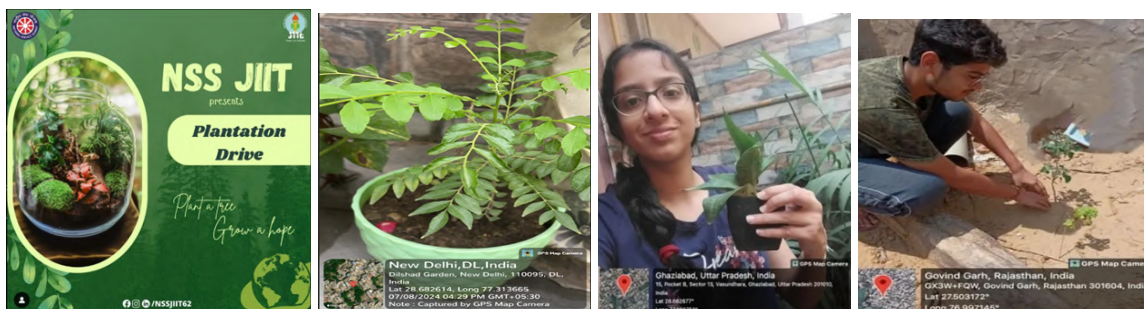
EVENT DETAILS:
