The Academic Council meeting was Chaired by Prof SC Saxena, Pro-Chancellor.

### ITEM 1: WELCOME AND OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHAIRPERSON

The Pro-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Academic Council and conveyed his gratitude to the external members for their presence in the meeting in online mode.

He informed the members about the conduct of the academic council meetings at regular intervals and consequent progress in academic matters at IIIT Noida.

The Pro-Chancellor appreciated the admission team which has resulted in a good response for admissions at IIIT Noida for the current academic year with approximately 7000 applications for 10+2 merit based and over 3000 applications for JEE AIR based admissions so far. The last date for applications for JEE based admission is 14 Aug 2022.

While the Institute has established itself for its academic performance in BTech and Integrate MTech program over the last 20 years and has been ranked in the top 100 engineering institutes by NIRF since 2016, there is a concern about the admissions to PG programs at IIIT. This issue is being addressed by the respective HoDs for their Departments.

The last date of withdrawing admission as given by UGC is 31 Dec 2022, accordingly the admission process will also continue till 31 Dec 2022. It is planned to start a new batch in end Dec 2022/ early Jan 2023 in accelerated mode to fill the gap of students who withdraw their admissions.

A new MBA program with specialization in Hospital and Healthcare Management is planned in the current academic year. The program will be run in JBSin association with Jaypee Healthcare System, Noida.

On the directions of the Hon'ble Chancellor, the following three committees have been established at Jaypee Universities: -

- (i) Special Group for Policy Implementation
- (ii) Ethics Committee
- (iii) National Education Policy-2020 Committee

The University will be celebrating the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' and 'Har Ghar Tiranga' initiatives from 11-17 Aug 2022 in consonance with the Govt Directions. It will be mandatory for employees to be present in the campus for the Independence Day celebrations on 15 Aug 2022.

The IIIT Foundation Day is celebrated on 27 August every year. This year, on this occasion there is an Art of Living Event in the forenoon and JEM- 2022 (IIIT Entrepreneur Meet) in the afternoon and evening. The invite to the alumni for participation in the Entrepreneur Meet has already been sent.

The Pro-Chancellor once again thanked the members for their presence and continued valuable inputs.

## ITEM 3: MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL AND REVIEW OF THE ACTION TAKEN REPORT

- (a) The Council considered and approved the Minutes of the last Academic Council Meeting held on 20 June 2022.

## ITEM 4: MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF STUDIES OF MATHEMATICS DEPT.

The Academic Council considered and approved the Minutes of Meetings of Board of Studies (BoS) for Mathematics Department. The major issues discussed in the BoS were informed to the members and are listed below:-

- (a) Introduction New elective course for BTech / Integrated MTech courses :
  - (i) Orthogonal Polynomials and Their Applications, 5<sup>th</sup> Semester Science Elective.
  - (ii) Advanced Statistical Methods, 7<sup>th</sup> Semester, Open Elective.
- (b) Introduction New elective course for MSc:
  - (i) Fluid Dynamics, 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester
  - (ii) Wave Propagation, 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester.
  - (iii) Data Structure, 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester.
- (c) Curriculum for the BSc (Hons) Programs (the detailed curricula for the first year).
- (d) Introduction of OBE for BSc (Hons) along with PO, PEO&PSO.
- (e) Program Attainment of MSc for the year 2020-21.

**ITEM 5: NATIONAL HAPPINESS RANKINGS & 'CHAMP' PROGRAM**

- 5.1 The council members were informed about the introduction of the National Happiness Rankings & 'CHAMP' (Campus Happiness Ambassador Program) to enhance the 'EQ' and 'IQ' of the students that is becoming equally important to the employers as the academic scores of the students. The program has been introduced by AICTE with the intention to support, promote and ensure happiness across all campuses and declare happiness rankings through YourOneLife (YOL) App.
- 5.2 The Academic Council considered and approved the same.

**ITEM 6: UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUE (UHV) COURSE FOR STUDENTS**

The council members considered and approved the following AICTE mandate with respect to UHV:

- (a) UHV-I module to be covered during Student Induction Program.
- (b) UHV-II module to be taught as a compulsory subject for all UG degree course in Engineering and Technology with 3 exclusive credits either in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> semester for all branches of Engineering students.
- (c) Minor Degree in UHV to be offered from AY 2022-23. The courses which are part of the minor degree, to be offered as open electives, to all students. A minor degree can be awarded on completion of 18 to 20 credits in the open elective UHV courses.
- (d) The Universities to identify and prepare adequate number of faculty to teach the UHV courses.

**ITEM 7: CONVERSION OF 3 YEARS BBA PROGRAM INTO 3/4 YEARS AS PER NEP 2020 POLICY.**

- 7.1 The three years full time BBA program was introduced in JIIT in Academic Year 2019-20. The first batch has passed out in 2022.

The council members were informed that in consonance with the National Education Policy (NEP-2020), the BBA program from Academic Year 2022-23 would be of four years with permission to exit the program after completion of three years. The degree would be awarded as follows:

- (a) BBA degree after successful completion of 3 years (6 semesters) of program.
- (b) BBA with Research/ Academic Projects/ Entrepreneurship degree after successful completion of 4 years (8 semesters) of program.

- 7.2 The Academic Council approved the same.

**ITEM 8: AMENDMENTS IN THE ACADEMIC SYSTEM FOR BTECH PROGRAM.**

The academic council approved the following amendments in the academic system applicable for all BTech & Integrated MTech Programs:

- (a) Para 3.4 -Value Added and Foreign Language Audit Courses
- (b) Para 3.12 - Earning Credits through MOOC's
- (c) Para 5.7 - Provision for improvement of grade(s)

**ITEM 9: ACADEMIC SYSTEM & CURRICULA FOR NEW B.SC PROGRAMS INTRODUCED IN AY 2022-23.**

9.1 The following three new B.Sc programs have been introduced in JIIT from academic session 2022-23.

- (a) BSc in Computer Science
- (b) BSc in IT & Applications
- (c) BSc in Computing and Programming

9.2 The council approved the curricula and the academic system for the BSc (H) programs.

**ITEM 10: AMENDMENT IN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN M.TECH-ECE (MSIOT) PROGRAM.**

In addition to the existing eligibility criteria, the candidate having the basic qualification as M.Sc (Physics) or M.Sc (ECE/ Electronics) will be eligible for admission to MTech in ECE with specialization in Microelectronic Systems and Internet of Things (MSIOT) from academic year 2022-23.

The Academic Council approved the following amendment in eligibility criteria:

“BE/B. Tech in EE/ EEE/ ECE/ CSE / IT/ Instrumentation, M. Sc (Physics) or M.Sc (ECE/ Electronics)”.

**ITEM 11: AMENDMENT IN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN M.SC-ECONOMICS PROGRAM.**

The Academic Council approved the following amendment in eligibility criteria for M.Sc-Economics for admission for academic year 2022-23 :

“Bachelor’s degree (3-years/ Hons.) in any subject securing the minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade point on a 10 point scale in the aggregate, through the examinations conducted by a university/autonomous institution or possesses such qualifications as recognized by the concerned university as equivalent to an undergraduate degree”.

**ITEM 12: REPORT ON CURRENT PLACEMENT STATUS (AS ON 25 JULY 2022)**

The Academic Council noted the placement status of students graduating in 2022 for B.Tech, M.Tech, Integrated M.Tech and MBA programs and comparative placement details for batches 2022, 2021 & 2020.

**ITEM 13: ANY OTHER ITEM WITH PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR**

Distribution of seats for the admission to BTech and Integrated MTech for academic year 2022-23

The academic council approved the following amendment of distribution of seats for the admission to BTech and Integrated MTech for academic year 2022-23 (previously approved in AC on 10 Mar 2022):

- (a) 50% through merit based on JEE 2022 AIR
- (b) 50% through merit based on 10+2 marks.

- (c) The unfulfilled seats of one category may be transferred to the other category.  
The final percentages may vary accordingly.

There being no other point, the meeting ended with vote thanks to the chair.

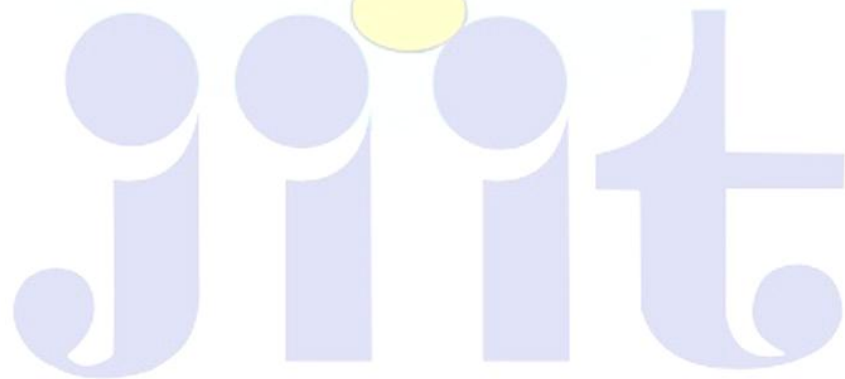
