- Total Revenue/Income of the Institute for the Year decreased by 22.75% from Rs 11176 lakh to Rs. 8633 Lakh. This decrease is mainly on account of Covid -19 relief package provided in fee to students and non occupancy of hostel during Covid period in Academic Year 2020-21.
- Fixed Assets Addition to the Fixed Assets during the year amounted to Rupees 330 Lakh.

- Cash & Bank Balances: Cash & Bank balances at the close of the financial year were Rs. 7238 Lakh including Corpus Fund of Rs. 1500 Lakh, and Accumulation under section 11(2) of Income Tax Act 1961 Rs. 1500.85 Lakhs. The remaining balance amount was for utilization towards payment of outstanding liabilities and payment for expenses for the period from April 2021 to June 2021.
- The outstanding balance of the Term Loan from Bank at the close of the year amounted to Rs. 6902 Lakh. Loan repayments made during the year – Rs 328 Lakh.






