BTech Passing Out Batch 2016-17: Academic Schedule

- 1. Ensuring safety and security of students during the COVID-19 pandemic and following the spirit of UGC guidelines, JIIT is conducting the evaluation process online. The details have been communicated to all the students and are uploaded on the Institute website.
- 2. The online evaluation and assessment process is being implemented to ensure the availability of students, placed in various Industries/organizations, to join by early July 2020. The following process in being followed:
 - a) **Test-2.** Conducted in online mode from 28 30 May 2020.
 - b) **End Semester Exam**: The End Sem Examination will be held online, in proctored format, from 18 to 20 June 2020.
 - c) **Make-up Test**. Make-up test is scheduled from 25-26 June 2020. The students who have missed out on the test-2, for any reason, and the approved list of students who could not appear in test-1, would be eligible for the make-up test.
 - d) On-Campus from 01-11 Jul 2020. Students, who could not effectively get connected to the online studies for any reason, will be given an opportunity to come to the Institute campus for their remedial classes and conduct of left over exams. Students completing all academic requirements in online mode would not be required to report to the Institute.
- 3. **Vacation of Hostels**. Students of BTech batch 2016-17, who complete all academic requirements in online mode and are residing in the hostels, can vacate the hostels between 20-27 June 2020.
 - a) To ensure safety of students during movement in the campus, the students arrival will be coordinated by JIIT. Students desirous of arriving in the campus to vacate the hostel should convey their proposed date by mail to Admin Manager at admin.manager@jiit.ac.in. No student would be allowed to stay for more than 04 hours in the campus to ensure safety protocols. No overnight stay in campus would be permitted under any circumstances.
 - b) In case the students / representatives are not able to come to the campus for vacating the occupied rooms, they should inform at the above mail latest by 19 June 2020. A team formed by JIIT would open the rooms & store the room items in bag(s) in the respective rooms to be identified by the occupants on arrival. The Almirahs would remain locked. Any open Almirah would be locked by the team.
