7th International Conference on Advances in Biosciences and Biotechnology (ICABB-2024)

The International Conference on Advances in Biotechnology and Biosciences (ICABB 2024) was successfully organised at Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida, under the theme "Food & Microbial Biotechnology: Insights and Innovations". 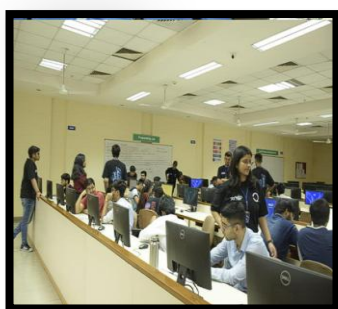

The JIIT Student Conference on Optics and Photonics-2024 (JSCOP-2024) was held on 27 April 2024 in offline mode at the Department of Physics and Material Science and Engineering (PMSE), JIIT Noida. The conference was organised to enlighten students about recent advances and research directions in optics and photonics. The event featured plenary talks by leading scientists, including Prof. Gagan Kumar (IIT Guwahati) on "Terahertz and Meta Photonics," and Dr. Bipin Kumar Gupta (CSIR-NPL) on "2D Quantum Materials." The sessions covered both theoretical and experimental aspects of cutting-edge topics such as plasmonics, metamaterials, luminescent nanomaterials, and quantum dots. Alongside academic discourse, the conference hosted engaging technical events including Photonics (a science photography contest), Electrifying Dash (a logic gate circuit-building challenge), Code Wars (a coding competition), and Secret Games (a gaming tournament).

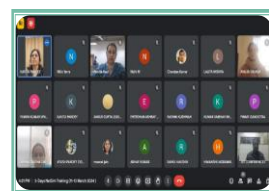

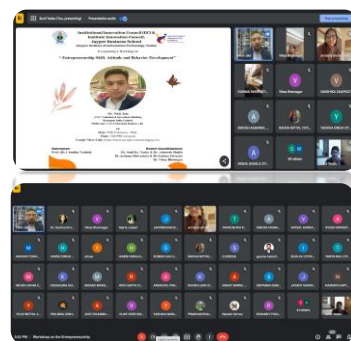
Three-Day Workshop on Blockchain and Its Applications to Industry 4.0

It first evolved as a backbone technology in a cryptocurrency called Bitcoin in the year 2009. The flexibility in decentralised transaction sharing, cryptographic tamper-proof data creation, and its verification received significant attention in developing secured enterprise applications with Blockchain. Further, several Blockchain frameworks have been developed by vendors for immediate use.

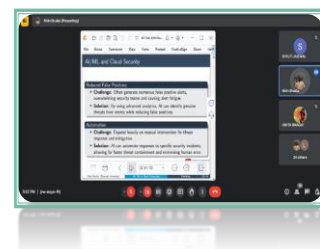
Bioinformatics approaches in metagenomics sequence analysis

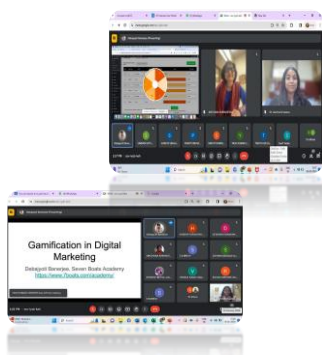

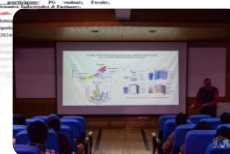
Customer Acquisition and Engagement in Digital Marketing through Gamification and AI

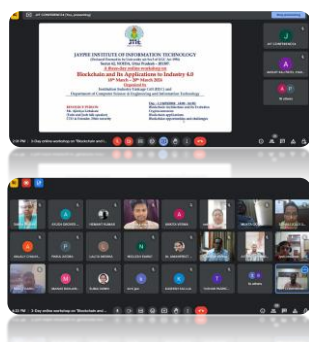
Prototype/Process Design and Development

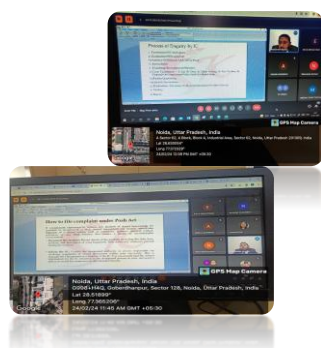

Role of Women in Shaping the Society.

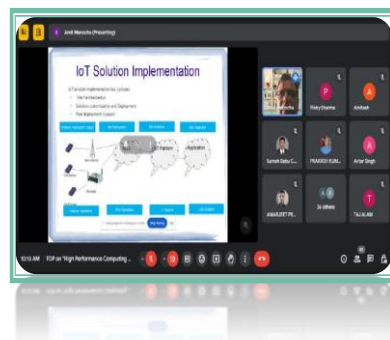

Empowering Researchers with AI Techniques

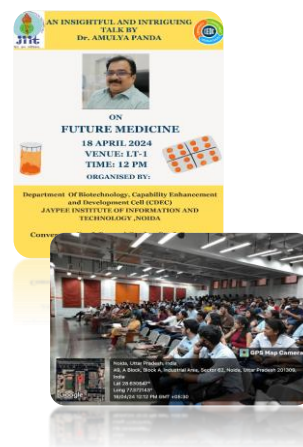

Drawing from his experience across top firms like Oyo, Spinny, and Practo, Mr. Suman advised students on building strong resumes, cover letters, and LinkedIn profiles, and creating a pool of 50 target companies.



Digital Marketing

On 28 April 2024, Jaypee Business School hosted an insightful session on "Digital Marketing" by alumnus Mr. Devansh Gill, Content Manager at The Brand Brew. Drawing from his diverse experience, Mr. Gill elaborated on key areas such as SEO, social media, content marketing, influencer strategy, and performance marketing. He also discussed the workflow between brands and digital agencies, emphasising collaboration across roles like SEO experts, designers, and video editors. Recommended tools included Canva, Gemini, Adobe Creator, ChatGPT, and Sprout Social to enhance digital marketing proficiency.



Non-Gaussian operations in quantum teleportation and quantum key distribution

A technical talk on "Non-Gaussian Operations in Quantum Teleportation and Quantum Key Distribution" was organised by the Department of Physics and Materials Science & Engineering (PMSE), JIIT Noida, on 12 June 2024. The speaker, Dr. Chandan Kumar, a postdoctoral fellow at IMSc Chennai, delivered an insightful session on the role of non-Gaussian operations in advancing the performance and security of continuous variable quantum information protocols.



EXPERT TALK

Leptogenesis: A possible explanation of the baryon asymmetry of the universe

A talk on “Leptogenesis: A Possible Explanation of the Baryon Asymmetry of the Universe” was organised by the Department of Physics and Materials Science & Engineering (PMSE), JIIT Noida, on 2 September 2024. Dr. Indrani Chakraborty, Assistant Professor (Senior Grade) at JIIT, delivered the lecture, offering a comprehensive overview of the leptogenesis mechanism as a theoretical solution to the observed baryon asymmetry in the universe. The talk delved into how specific extensions of the Standard Model of particle physics can account for the matter-antimatter imbalance through lepton number-violating processes.



Quantum Batteries

A session on “Quantum Batteries” was conducted by Mr. Kuldeep Gangwar, a project student in the quantum optics lab at JIIT under the supervision of Prof. Anirban Pathak and an MSc Physics graduate from IIT Delhi. The session explored the conceptual and operational differences between conventional and quantum batteries, emphasising their potential advantages in energy storage and efficiency. Mr. Gangwar discussed theoretical models such as the Dicke quantum battery and quantum harmonic oscillator battery.



Symmetry: The Grand Rule of Nature

A session titled “Symmetry: The Grand Rule of Nature” was delivered by Dr. Ram Lal Awasthi, Assistant Professor at Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi. Dr. Awasthi, whose research centres on Beyond Standard Model Physics and Grand Unification, emphasised the central role of symmetry in understanding the fundamental laws of nature. The talk explored how symmetry governs both microscopic and macroscopic phenomena, serving as a unifying thread in physical theories—from space-time geometry to particle interactions.



EXPERT TALK

An Industry Perspective on Large-Scale Database

The Department of Computer Science and Engineering & Information Technology, JIIT Noida, organised an invited talk titled "Choosing the Right Database: An Industry Perspective on Large-Scale Database" on January 30, 2024. The session, coordinated by Dr. Indu Chawla, was delivered by Mr. Rishav Katoch, Product Engineer at Atlan, Singapore. The talk aimed to raise awareness among students about selecting suitable databases for different applications, especially in the context of growing data volumes.



Pseudo-Spheres and Regularity vs Compactness



The Department of Mathematics at Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, Noida, organised a talk on "Pseudo-Spheres and Regularity vs Compactness" on 18 January 2024, featuring Prof. Eberhard Malkowsky as the invited speaker. Prof. Malkowsky, a distinguished mathematician affiliated with Drzavni University Novi Pazar, Serbia, and formerly at the University of Giessen, Germany, has authored over 181 research papers and several books, and has an extensive academic footprint in functional analysis and operator theory.

Mathematics of Neural Network Operators

The Department of Mathematics at Jaypee Institute of Information Technology organised an interactive session on "Mathematics of Neural Network Operators" on April 24, 2024, featuring Dr. Seda Keratake from the Department of Software Engineering, Istanbul Atlas University, Turkey. Conducted in online mode, the one-hour session provided an insightful exploration of the foundational mathematical structures underpinning artificial neural networks (ANNs).



EXPERT TALK

Iterated Function System of Generalized Cyclic Contractions in Partial Metric Space.

An expert interactive session on “Iterated Function System of Generalised Cyclic Contractions in Partial Metric Space” was organised by the Department of Mathematics, Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, on January 29, 2024. The session was conducted in offline mode and delivered by Prof. Melusi Khumalo, Chair of the Department of Mathematical Sciences, University of South Africa. The session aimed to deepen participants’ understanding of contraction conditions, fixed point theory, and their mathematical applications, particularly in fractal generation.



Orientation of the Certificate Course in Data Analytics for M.Sc. Students

An orientation session for the newly introduced *Certificate Course in Data Analytics* was organised by the Department of Mathematics, Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, Noida, on January 6, 2024. 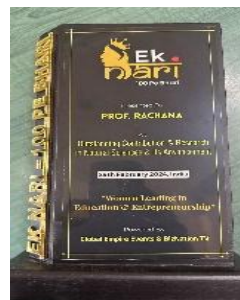

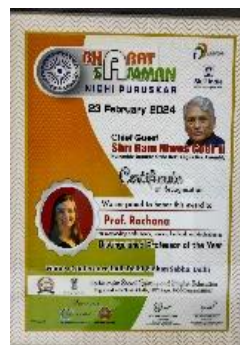
Prof. Rachana Honoured for Excellence in Natural Sciences

Solo Singing Achievement at Deshbandhu College, DU

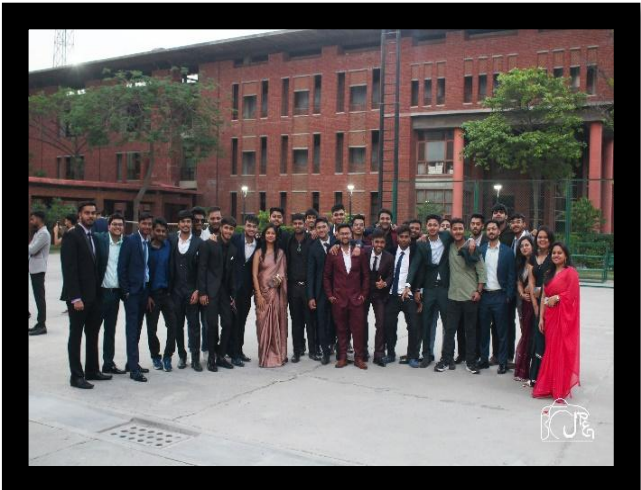

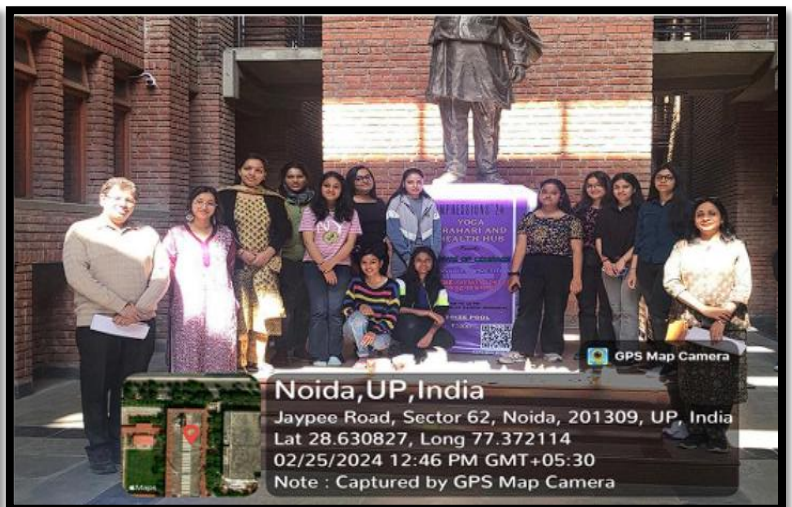

CANVAS OF COURAGE: SAY NO TO DRUGS

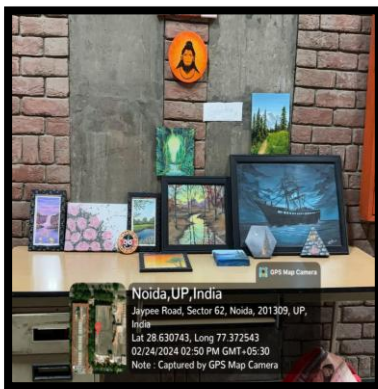

Debate Competition on Martyrs' Day

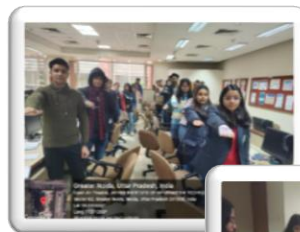

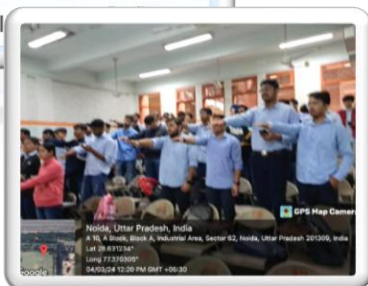
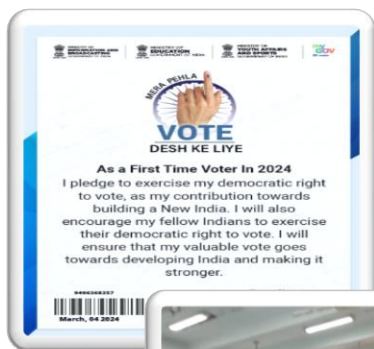
Voter Awareness Campaign

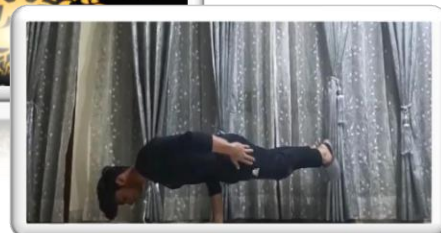
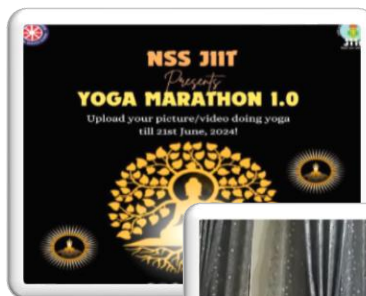

The cell operates with a clear mandate: (a) to provide an academic environment and safeguard the IPR of all those involved in formulating innovation at JIIT; (b) to improve and advance research standards at par with levels which can be easily translated to IPRs; (c) to encourage innovations in the institute; (d) to create awareness about the rules and regulations amongst the inventors; and (e) to lay down a policy and guidelines for management of intellectual property.

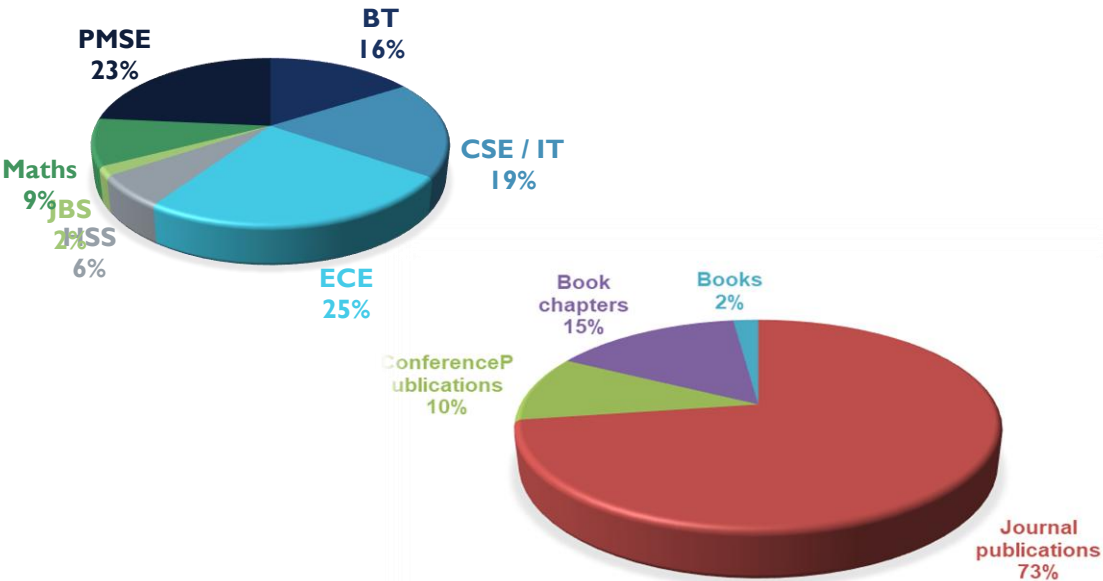
JIIT PUBLICATIONS CALENDER YEAR 2023

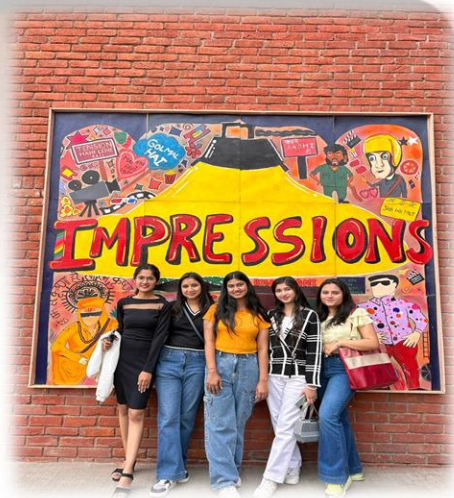
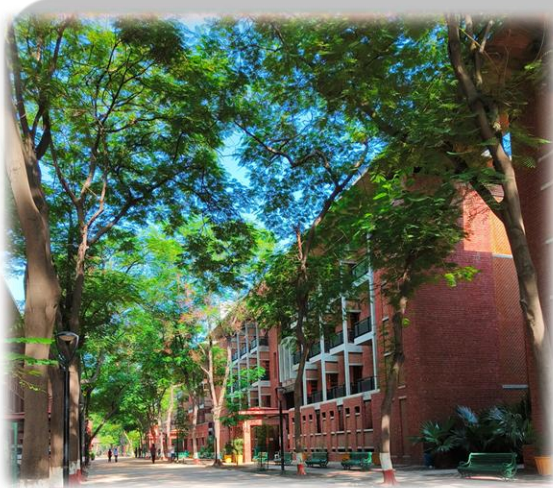
In 2023, JIIT witnessed a robust research output across diverse academic disciplines, reflecting its commitment to scholarly excellence and innovation. Among the total publications, 73% were journal articles, followed by 10% conference papers, 15% book chapters, and 2% books, indicating a strong emphasis on peer-reviewed scholarly dissemination. Notably, 491 publications were indexed in SCOPUS, with 240 appearing in prestigious SCI/SCIE (Web of Science) journals and 57 recognised as peer-reviewed contributions. Department-wise, PMSE led the publication share with 23%, followed by ECE (25%), CSE/IT (19%), Biotechnology (16%), Mathematics (9%), Humanities and Social Sciences (6%), and JBS (2%).
