

**ACADEMIC YEAR: 2021-22**

**REMITTANCE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF INSTITUTIONAL FEES UNDER NRI / NRI  
SPONSORED / FOREIGN NATIONALS CATEGORIES**

- The Academic Fees for students being admitted in session 2021-22 shall be USD 4350 per semester (USD 8700 per annum), Hostel charges shall be USD 1200 per semester (USD 2400 per annum). Hostel charges may be paid in INR equivalent to USD1200. Caution Money shall be Rs 10,000/- (payable in INR), one time charges applicable for first year student and refundable after completion of program.**
- REMITTANCE PROCEDURE FOR ALL BATCHES (Charges as applicable to the year of Admission):**

Any of the following two modes may be used:

- Remittance through **Wire transfer** from the sponsor.
- Remittance through **NRE Accounts in India**, maintained by the sponsor.

**Note:** Payment of Academic Fees shall not be accepted through any other mode except the two modes mentioned above.

**(I) REMITTANCE THROUGH WIRE TRANSFER FROM THE SPONSOR.**

The NRI or foreign national/ Sponsor would have to give instructions for **Wire Transfer** to his Bank. The Wire Transfer may be made to IDBI Bank as per details below:

**Notes:**

- Swift Copy (Wire transfer advice/MT103) should be sent by email at **fees@jiit.ac.in** for information of the Institute.
- All banks charges in foreign and in India, in connection with the Fees remittance will be charged to the account of the Remitter/Student. Any Shortage in the prescribed Fees amount, on account of bank charges credited to the Institute's A/c shall be borne by the student.

**(II) REMITTANCE THROUGH NRE ACCOUNT OF THE SPONSOR WITH A SCHEDULED BANK IN INDIA**

Fees can also be paid out of a **NRE** Account maintained by the sponsor with a Schedule Bank in India. The sponsor should instruct the bank to issue a **PAY ORDER / DD** in favor of '**Jaypee Institute of Information Technology' payable at Noida / Delhi.**

The pay order or DD should be denominated in Indian Rupees for an amount equivalent to USD 4350 per semester (**USD 8700 per annum**) as Academic Fees.

In above case, the sponsor should take a certificate from the bank stating that "the pay order No..... dated..... for Rs..... has been issued out of the funds parked in ..... NRE Account of the Sponsor..... (Name)..... with the bank and the Exchange Rate of Rs.....is considered for the USD".

The student would be required to deposit the Pay Order along with the above Certificate with the Institute at the time of admission or as given in the admission letter.

The payment of Fees by PAY ORDER / DD from NRE A/C without the above said Bank Certificate shall not be accepted.

**(III) PAYMENT OF HOSTEL CHARGES IN INR**

Hostel charges may be paid in INR equivalent to USD 1200 by the student through **DD** in favor of '**Jaypee Institute of Information Technology' payable at Noida / Delhi** or through **Credit /Debit Card** mode available at Fees Counter of the institute. The exchange rate shall be counted on the day of Fees deposited with the Institute.

**(IV) PAYMENT OF CAUTION MONEY IN INR**

Caution money of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand Only) which is one time charges applicable for first year student is refundable after completion of program, may be paid through **DD** in favor of '**Jaypee Institute of Information Technology' payable at Noida / Delhi** or through **Credit /Debit Card** mode available at Fees Counter of the institute.
