**Students Exit Feedback Report 2018-19**

Exit feedback was taken from final year students of B.Tech., M.Tech. and MBA on the last day of their college. They were asked to rate ten parameters on 1 to 5 scales where 1 means Fair, 2 means Good, 3 means Very Good, 4 means Excellent and 5 means Outstanding. Out of around 987 forms filled up by students, average scores have been calculated and shown in table below.

It may be observed from the above table that the students have given 'Very good' rating to curriculum structure, teaching and learning, laboratory facilities, library, examination and evaluation system. Hostel and mess facilities have received 'Good' rating. Services with Registry and Accounts departments have also received 'Good' rating.

On the basis of ratings and comments provided by students, the following recommendations have been made by IQAC-

1. Registry and Accounts personnel may be provided soft skills training so that they deal with students more politely and appropriately.

2. Hostel facility may be provided at JIIT sec-128 so that students save time in commuting.
3. Mess facility and quality of food may be improved.
4. Students may be provided more opportunities for participation in extracurricular activities.
5. Sports facilities may be enhanced by providing more sport equipments both at Sec-62 and Sec-128.
