SCHOLARSHIPS : Academic Year 2024-25

1. Fee Waiver Scholarship (MSc, MCA, MBA & Diploma Programs).

(a) Scholarship (Fee waiver) schemes from 15 % to 50% of tuition fees:

CGPA or equivalent percentage /marks in Qualifying Exam / Degree	Scholarship
6.00 – 7.49 (Only for JHES students for MBA)	15%
7.50 – 7.99	20%
8.00 – 8.49	30%
8.50 – 8.99	40%
≥9.00	50%

Note: The scholarship on CGPA of 6.00 to 7.49 in qualifying exam is applicable only for students of Jaypee Higher Education System (JHES) for admission to MBA program.

(b) Number of Scholarships:

- (i) MBA – 30
- (ii) MCA – 10
- (iii) MSc – 10 per Dept
- (iv) Diploma – 10 per Dept

(c) Continuation of Scholarship.

- (i) Fresh merit list will be prepared for each department on completion of a semester.
- (ii) For continuation of scholarship, SGPA as per table above is required in every semester.

2. Teaching Assistantship (MTech Program).

(a) GATE Qualified. Candidates – eligible for TA as per existing policy (Rs. 15000/- per month).

(b) Non-Gate Candidates.

- (i) Teaching Assistantship @ Rs. 15000/- per month.
- (ii) CGPA ≥ 7.5 or equivalent marks in qualifying degree at the time of admission.
- (iii) To be awarded for one semester.
- (iv) For continuation of TA, SGPA ≥ 7.5 is required in every semester.

3. Scholarship to Girl Students (Parent's Income ≤ Rs 50,000/- per month)

- (a) Scholarship - 50 % waiver of tuition fees for the minimum period of the degree.
- (b) Applicable for BTech program Only
- (c) Two girl students per course as per the merit of admission (01 each through JEE AIR and 10+2 based, if admission through both modes, else 10+2).
- (d) Students with parent's income from all sources ≤ Rs 50,000/- per month will be eligible. Valid Income Certificate issued by the State Authorities only will be accepted.
- (e) Scholarship continuity will be subject to maintaining CGPA of 7.50 (i.e CGPA of 7.50 in first Sem for continuity in second Sem and so on)
- (f) Scholarships will be awarded after last date of Admission.

4. **Scholarship to Board Toppers – Admission to BTech programs**

- (a) Topper of 10+2 exams, conducted in 2024, of the recognised boards in India
- (b) Admission as per eligibility of admission to BTech program
- (c) Admission to BTech program of choice
- (d) Proof / certificate from Board to be provided by the candidate
- (e) Scholarship - 50 % waiver of tuition fees
- (f) Scholarship continuity will be subject to maintaining CGPA of 7.50 (i.e CGPA of 7:50 in first Sem for continuity in second Sem and so on)
- (g) Scholarship will be awarded for the minimum period of degree (i.e 04 years).

5. **AICTE Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme (TFW)**

- (a) Supernumerary Seats
- (b) TFW to 1% of approved seats of program, as per merit.
- (c) Seat details as follows;

- (d) Student's whose parents annual income from all sources does not exceed Rs 8.00 lakhs per annum will be eligible. Valid Income Certificate issued by the State Authorities only will be accepted.
- (e) Scholarships will be awarded after last date of Admission

6. **William Webster Merit-cum-Means Scholarship.**

- (a) Students will get a tuition fee waiver in the academic year, equivalent to the tuition fee of one semester.
- (b) Two scholarships (one each in Sector 62 and Sector 128) awarded in BTech program.
- (c) Eligibility : Combined income of parent should be less than Rs. 8.0 Lac per annum.
- (d) Merit list prepared in second semester considering student's marks in class 10th, class 12th and result of first semester.
- (e) Scholarship is awarded in Even Semester every year.
- (f) Scholarship continuity is subject to maintaining CGPA of 7.00 in subsequent semesters and submission of valid income certificate issued by the State Authorities.
