## 2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

**2.1** The medium of instruction in the University is English.

#### **2.2** Application Forms:

- (a) Application forms for all programs of admission are available online at www.jiit.ac.in. Apply online through the website in https://getadmissions.com/jaypee or collect offline forms from the admission counter of the University.
- (b) Candidates must ensure that mail ID and mobile phone number entered in the application form is continued till completion of admission process. All correspondence will be carried out on the registered email IDs. Mail ID once registered cannot be changed. Candidates are advised to use personal mail IDs and not to use corporate mail IDs.
- (c) If the APAAR (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) ID or ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) ID has been created by the applicant, the same maybe entered in the application form.
- (d) Follow the on-screen prompts to fill up the application form and make the payment through Credit card/Debit card/Net banking/UPI.
- (e) Once the payment is successful, an Application ID shall be allotted to the candidate, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation from getadmissions.com.
- (f) During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and parent.
- (g) Candidates must check their application form carefully before final submission, as no change will be permitted after submitting the form.
- (h) Candidates are advised to keep a copy of the application form for their reference.

- (i) Candidates can apply for more than one mode of admission. For example, if a candidate is applying under JEE (Main) 2025 category and also wants to apply under 10+2 basis or NRI category, the candidate must fill separate forms and pay the required application fee.
- (j) Candidates to ensure that results of 10+2/qualifying exam are uploaded before last date of application of the respective program.
- **2.3** Applications received after last date will not be accepted and candidates shall have no claim on the merit list and subsequent admission to the program.
- 2.4 The candidates are advised to check the website of the University for latest updates.
- **2.5** Display of Application Status: Candidates can view the receipt of their applications on the JIIT website within two working days of submission of the application form.
- 2.6 Candidates must have a pass result in all subjects in qualifying exam.
- **2.7** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible to apply for all UG programs. Last date of application for different programs is:

- **2.8** Candidates to upload required documents as applicable:
  - (a) For UG Program: 10+2 mark sheet.
  - (b) For PG Program: final year result or pre-final year/ semester mark sheet (for candidates appearing in qualifying examination in 2025).
  - (c) For BTech Lateral Entry Program: Final Semester Marksheet of UG degree/Diploma.
  - (d) For Diploma Program: 10th mark sheet.

**Note:** Candidates appearing in qualifying exam in 2025 to upload final Sem/year marksheet before the last date of application.

- **2.9** Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- **2.10** In case of State Boards issuing a single transcript / DMC mentioning the marks in 10+1 and 10+2, then for such boards, marks of both 10+1 & 10+2 will be taken into account while preparing the merit for 10+2 based admission.
- **2.11** Candidates will be considered for admission strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to verification of certificates of eligibility/qualification and depositing applicable academic fee.
- **2.12** All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original Certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, the admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.
- 2.13 Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.
- **2.14** For UG Program only: Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website) at the time of registration for the program.
- **2.15** Out of the seats available for counselling, 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on JEE Mains (AIR 2025) and 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on 10+2 marks merit.
- 2.16 Vacant seats are inter-transferable in either category i.e. JEE Mains AIR to 10+2 marks based or viceversa.
- **2.17 JEE Application Only:** While filling the JEE based application form for Jaypee Universities, candidates are advised to enter the same email id and mobile no. as mentioned in their NTA JEE Mains Application form.

2.18 Admission through Study in India (SII) Portal: As per instructions, received from Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, GOI, w.e.f. Academic Year 2025-26, it is mandatory for all foreign students coming for higher studies to India to mandatorily register on the SII Portal, and quote the Unique ID generated thereon in their visa applications. No foreign student would be able to get a student visa without registering on the SII Portal and quoting the Unique ID in the visa application.

## **5. RESERVATION OF SEATS**

5.1 Reservation for SC/ST candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.

#### BTech & Integrated MTech Program:

**5.2** Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW): 1% seats in Btech program shall be offered under TFW scheme. Seats will be allocated on merit. Candidates with family income less than 8 lakhs per annum are eligible. Valid Income Certificate issued by the State Authorities will be accepted.

- **5.3** Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS): 2 seats per course at JIIT, Noida are reserved for J&K students under this scheme.
- **5.4** Concession for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/Kashmiri Hindu Families (nonmigrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission at JIIT Noida will be as per MHRD letter No. 3-4/2017-NER dated October 15, 2019.

## 6. BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH (JEE BASED)

- **6.1** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible to apply.
- **6.2** Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination.
- 6.3 Candidates should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.
- **6.4** The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, and Entrepreneurship.
- **6.5** The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Mains) AIR 2025. Rank in no other category will be considered.

#### 6.6 CHOICE(S) OF INSTITUTES/BRANCHES -

- (a) During counselling the candidate will need to select any one Institute/University and give choice for any/all the programs of that Institute/ University as applicable.
- (b) For JIIT Noida candidates will have the option to select any one group as mentioned below:

#### 6.7 COUNSELLING INTIMATION:

- (a) Counselling will be based on Merit. Shortlisted candidates eligible for counselling on the specific date will be informed by email on registered mail ID's. List of candidates will also be uploaded on the website.
- (b) Ignorance/lapses, if any, in participating in the allotted counselling slot shall not be accepted as an excuse to participate in counselling at a later date.
- **6.8 COUNSELLING:** The first round of counselling will be common and conducted at JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round(s) of counselling will be held by respective Universities.

#### 6.9 Process of Counselling:

(a) 1st round of counselling shall be held at JIIT-Noida on 17-18 June 2025. The counselling intimation will be sent to the registered email id of the shortlisted candidates. Candidates can also view this list on the website.

- (b) All candidates (also appearing in 10+2 examination in 2025) are required to upload their results on getadmissions portal latest by 05 June, 2025.
- (c) Candidates called for counselling are permitted to exercise choice of only one University at the time of Counselling (No inter-university transfers are allowed).
- (d) Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE (Mains) AIR 2025.
- (e) Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of any program/branches within the selected University (Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the same university).
- (f) Seats in the programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of counselling.
- (g) During counselling a candidate can confirm the seat available or choose to be in wait list by depositing Rs. 75000/- (seventy-five thousand). The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (h) Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/credit Card / UPI / Demand Draft favoring "Jaypee Institutes Admission Account" payable at Noida/Delhi (Cheque and Cash are NOT acceptable).
- (i) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.
- (j) While filling the JEE based application form for Jaypee University, candidates must ensure that they write the same email id and mobile no. as mentioned in their NTA JEE Mains Application Form.
- **Note:** Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice form at the time of counselling and only one group can be selected by the candidate.

## 7. BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH (10+2 MARKS BASED)

- 7.1 Candidate's who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible.
- **7.2** Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).
- **7.3** Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination.
- 7.4 Candidates should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.
- 7.5 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, and Entrepreneurship.
- **7.6** Merit will be prepared on marks scored in Maths, Physics (both compulsory subjects) & one subject as mentioned in Para 7.5 above.
- 7.7 First round of counselling will be held on 10-11 June 2025. Further rounds will be held based on vacancies. Candidate will be called for counselling as per merit. Candidates are advised to check their email for the counselling intimation.
- **7.8** Counselling intimation will be as mentioned in Para 6.7 above.
- **7.9** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination in the year 2025 are responsible for uploading their results on getadmissions portal latest by 20 May 2025.
- 7.10 Applications with incomplete documents/results of 10+2 will not be considered for counselling. In case any state board issues a single transcript / DMC mentioning the marks in 10+1 and 10+2, then for such boards, average marks of both 10+1 & 10+2 will be taken into account while preparing the merit for 10+2 based admission.

#### 7.12 Process of Counselling:

- (a) Candidates as per merit list, who are called for counselling shall be allotted seats on the basis of merit drawn on marks scored in 10+2 in the 3 subjects as given in Para 7.5 above.
- (b) Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of all programs/branches. The candidate will be upgraded in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them.
- (c) During counselling a candidate can confirm the seat available or choose to be in waitlist by depositing Rs. 75000/- (seventy-five thousand). The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (d) Fee can be deposited through Debit Card / Credit Card / UPI / Demand Draft favoring "Jaypee Institute of Information Technology" payable at Noida / Delhi. Cheque and Cash are NOT acceptable.
- (e) After getting a seat student will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.

**Note:** Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice form at the time of counseling and only one group can be selected by the candidate.

## 8. DIRECT ADMISSION IN BTECH PROGRAMS:-AI & ML, EE (VLSI), EC (ACT), ECM, M&C, R&AI, CSE (CS)

#### 8.1 Eligibility:

- (a) Should have passed 10+2 in year 2023, 2024 or appearing in year 2025.
- (b) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination and should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.
- (c) The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, and Entrepreneurship.
- (d) Merit will be prepared on marks scored in Mathematics, Physics (both compulsory subjects) & one subject out of the list above.
- (e) In case any state board issues a single transcript / marksheet mentioning the marks in 10+1 and 10+2, then for such boards, average marks of the required subjects of both 10+1 & 10+2 will be taken into account while preparing the merit.
- **8.2** Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).

#### 8.4 Admission Process:

- (a) Candidates, filling the 10+2 application form for BTech admissions at JIIT, will have the option to apply for DIRECT ADMISSION Category.
- (b) Separate application number (DAG25xxxx) will be generated for candidates who opt for direct admission.
- (c) There is No separate / additional application fee.
- (d) Merit list will be prepared based as mentioned in Para 8.1 above.
- (e) Candidates, as per merit, will be called for admission to the programs.
- (f) A candidate can apply for only one of the programs when called for the admission process.
- (g) Admissions will be offered only against available seats. There will be No waiting list.
- (h) Candidate confirming admission (on deposition of fees) will not be eligible for admission under any other category of BTech/Integrated MTech programmes. Their candidature will accordingly be removed from all other BTech programs at JIIT.
- (i) No change of program/branch is allowed after admission is confirmed.

## 9. ADMISSION -10+2 MARKS BASED BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH IN BIOTECHNOLOGY

#### 9.1 Eligibility:

- (a) Candidate's who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible to apply.
- (b) For 10+2 marks based for admission in Biotechnology, the candidate must have passed with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and any one subject out of Biology, Biotechnology, Mathematics.
- (c) Candidates should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.

- (c) Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination must upload their results latest by 10 June 2025.
- (d) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).

## **10. ADMISSION IN NRI/NRI SPONSORED CATEGORY**

#### 10.1 Eligibility:

- (e) The selected candidates will be informed through e-mail. The candidate must therefore mention the correct primary email ID for faster processing.

#### **10.2 Admission Procedure:**

- (a) Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Institutional Fee within the specified dates mentioned in the offer letter. The selected candidates will be informed through e-mails. The candidate must therefore mention the correct primary email ID for faster processing.
- (b) In case admission is not confirmed by the candidate, the seat shall be allotted to next student on wait list as per merit.
- (c) The candidates will be informed to submit the following documents:
  - 10+2 or equivalent board mark sheet to be uploaded latest by 10 June 2025.
  - Sponsorship letter from NRI, (sponsoring the candidate) as per proforma which may be downloaded from the website.
  - Sponsor's passport copy.
- (d) Candidates granted admission under this category cannot opt for change to General category in subsequent years. However, candidates can apply for different category of admission (eg, JEE(Main), 10+2 Merit) by filling separate application forms as applicable.

- (h) AI & ML: Candidate should have passed Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern in any discipline with Mathematics/Computer Science/IT/Statistics/Operations Research as a subject or BCA securing minimum 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in the aggregate.
- (i) Computer Science: Candidate should have passed Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern in any discipline with Mathematics/Computer Science/IT/Statistics/Operations Research as a subject or BCA securing minimum 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in the aggregate.

Sc. in Electronics /Instrumentation/ Physics with at least 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10 point scale in the aggregate.
- (d) AI & DS: B.Tech/BE in any discipline / MCA / MSc. (Maths/Operation Research/Statistics/Physics) with 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on 10-point scale in the aggregate and candidate should have studied Mathematics in class 12th.
- (e) Robotics & AI: B.Tech/B.E degree in Electronics Engineering and all allied branches, Computer Science Engineering and all allied branches, Mechanical Engineering or equivalent with atleast 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10 point scale in the aggregate.

Application Fee is non-refundable and in the event of non-eligibility of the candidate seeking refund of the application fee shall be summarily rejected.

### 4. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

#### 4.1 BTech Programs

- (a) Candidates who have passed 10+2/ equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are only eligible to apply for the Program. Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in10+2 or equivalent examination and should have secured a Pass grade.
- (b) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BTech Program, will be required to submit Gap Period affidavit as per the format available at University Website.
- (c) For JEE (Mains) based admission, candidates should have qualified JEE (Mains) 2025 All India Rank (AIR) and should have passed or appeared in 10+2 Examination or equivalent (as defined in JEE (Mains) 2025) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English from any recognized Board with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks.
- (d) For 10+2 marks-based admissions, candidates should have passed 10+2 examination or its equivalent examination with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate or equivalent grade from the Boards recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE).
  - (i) 10+2 marks based (Non-JEE Candidates) for admission in branches other than Biotechnology / Bioinformatics: The candidate should have minimum of 60% aggregate marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English. CUET-UG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to BTech Program.
  - (ii) 10+2 marks based (Non-JEE Candidates) for admission in Biotechnology /Bioinformatics Program: The candidate should have minimum of 60% aggregate marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Biology/ Biotechnology as compulsory subjects along with two subjects out of Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subjects, Electronics, Entrepreneurship, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies and English. CUET-UG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to BTech Program.
- 4.2 BTech (Lateral Entry) Directly to 2nd Year The candidate should have passed / appeared (in final semester/ year) 03 Year Diploma Program with 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or its equivalent CGPA from recognized Board / University. Candidates who have passed BTech 1st Year Examination with 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or its equivalent CGPA from the recognized University / Institutions are also eligible for admission to the Program.
- 4.3 BBA Program Candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or equivalent grade from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE). CUET-UG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to BBA Program.
- 4.4 BCA Program Candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 55% (50% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or equivalent grade from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE). CUET-UG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to BCA Program.
- 4.5 MSc Program in Biotechnology, Microbiology -
  - 4.5.1 Non DBT Biotechnology/ Microbiology Candidate should have passed BSc (Hons)/ BSc or an equivalent Undergraduate Degree in any branch of Life Sciences/ Medical Sciences/ any branch

of Biology under 10+2+3 pattern securing 50% aggregate marks (45% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in aggregate. Candidates having CGPA  $\geq$  7.5 or equivalent percentage in qualifying examination will be considered for direct admission to MSc Program. CUET-PG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to MSc (Microbiology)/MSc (Biotechnology) Program.

- **4.5.2 DBT Supported MSc Biotechnology** 10 Seats of MSc (Biotechnology) program are supported by DBT and admission to such seats is through Qualified Rank of GAT-B-2025 in order of merit.
- 4.6 MTech Program Candidate should have passed four-year Bachelor's degree in the relevant discipline with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) marks or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in aggregate from a recognized University / Institution. Admission is through PGET (PG Entrance Test) conducted by Jaypee University of Information Technology. The condition of admission on the basis of merit of PGET Test for candidates having CGPA ≥ 7.5 or equivalent percentage in qualifying examination has been relaxed and such candidates will be offered direct admission to the MTech Program. GATE Qualified candidates are exempted from PGET Entrance Test. However, they have to appear for the interview. CUET-PG-2025 qualified candidates shall also be considered for admission to MTech Program.
- 4.7 PhD Program 1-Year / 2-Semester (or 2-year/4-semester) Master's Degree program after a 4-year / 8-Semester Bachelor's Degree program OR a 2-Year / 4-Semester Master's Degree program after a 3-year Bachelor's Degree program with at least 60% marks in aggregate or CGPA not less than 06 on scale of 10 OR 4-Year / 8-Semester Bachelor's Degree program with 75% aggregate marks or CGPA not less than 7.5 on scale of 10. Consistently good academic record / performance is desirable

Selection will be based on the PhD Entrance test followed by interview conducted by Jaypee University of Information Technology. NET/ SLET/ UGC/ CSIR (JRF) candidates are exempted from the PhD Entrance Test but have to appear for the interview.

#### General to all programs :

- All candidates who are offered provisional admission will be required to produce proof of having
  passed the qualifying examination to the University authorities latest by September 30, 2025 failing
  which, such provisional admission will stand automatically cancelled. No representation for extension
  of dates, for whatsoever reasons, shall be entertained.
- All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, his/ her admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.
- Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate. Application Fee is non-refundable and request for refund of application fee shall be summarily rejected in case of candidate not found eligible for admission to the program.
- Candidates appearing in qualifying examinations prescribed above in the year 2025 can also apply for admission. However, admission is based on marks merit, the result must be submitted before the preparation of merit as per admission calendar 2025. Candidates who fail to submit their result at the time of preparation of merit list may be considered for admission at the later stage subject to availability of the seat to the program and on submission of result of the qualifying examination.

- **5.1.3** Once the payment has been successfully made, the candidate shall be allotted an Application ID, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation.
- **5.1.4** During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and the parent.
- **5.1.5** You must keep a copy of the application form for your future records, but no need to send hard copy of the application form through post / courier in case of online submission of application form and payment of online application fee.

#### 5.3 For Offline Application forms procured from Admission Counter of the University,

- **5.3.2** Fill-in all fields, attach the photograph and sign the application form. No need of making any payment towards application fee, if application forms procured after payment of application fee from the Admission Counter of the University.
- 5.4 For JEE (Main) 2025 based admission, JEE application number, JEE Roll number and JEE AIR (All India Rank) should be filled at appropriate places in the form. ### 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- 6.1 Reservation for SC/ST/ candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.
- 6.2 For admissions in BTech (Biotechnology and Bioinformatics) programs, 50% seats shall be filled on the basis of JEE (Main) 2025 All India Rank and 50% seats shall be filled on the basis of 10+2 marks with Biology/ Biotechnology as core subject in 10+2 examination. However, seats are inter-transferable in either category considering number of applications to each category.
- **6.3** For admissions in BTech (Other than Biotechnology / Bioinformatics) programs, 50% seats shall be allotted through JEE (Main) 2025 All India Rank. Remaining 50% seats shall be filled through Counseling based on merit, drawn on the basis of marks of 10+2 examination. However, seats are inter-transferable in either category considering number of applications to each category.
- 6.4 10% seats at JUIT, Waknaghat for BTech program only are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel. 30% concession in Tuition Fee for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel will be provided to candidate admitted under such category for BTech program only. Additional 5% concession (i.e. 35%) in Tuition Fee will be provided for wards of War Widows and personnel killed in action or persons with disability during the services.

- 6.5 10% seats at JUIT, Waknaghat are reserved for Himachal Pradesh (HP) category candidates only subject to the condition that candidate has qualified the 10+2 examination from any of the schools/Institutions located in the state of Himachal Pradesh. Merely holding the Himachal bonafide certificate does not entitle for admission under the Himachal Pradesh (HP) Category.
- **6.6** Reservation for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non- Migrants) living in Kashmir valley as per MHRD letter No. 3-4/2017-NER dated October 15, 2019.
- **6.7** Supernumerary seats for candidates who have been issued with PM CARES for Children Scheme Certificate 2021.

## 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - JEE MAIN 2025 ALL INDIA RANK BASED BTECH PROGRAM

- **7.1** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are only eligible to apply for the program.
- **7.2** Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).
- **7.3** Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination and should have secured a Pass grade.
- 7.4 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English.
- **7.5** The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Main) 2025 All India Rank (AIR). Rank in other category shall not be considered for drawing merit for admission to the program.
- **7.6 CHOICE(S) OF INSTITUTES / BRANCHES -** During counselling the candidate will need to select any one Institute/University and give choice for any/all the programs/ branches of that particular Institute/ University only.

#### 7.7 COUNSELLING INTIMATION:

Counselling will be based on Merit of JEE (Mains) 2025 All India Rank. Candidates eligible for counselling on a specific date will be informed through the email on the registered mail ID's as given in the application form. Counselling information shall also be uploaded on the Website of the University for information of the candidates.

Ignorance/lapses, in participating in the allotted counselling slot shall not be accepted as an excuse to participate in counselling at a later date. Such candidates shall be considered for the subsequent counselling but will forfeit the merit claim and seat will be offered as per the availability of seat to the program on the day of counselling only.

#### 7.8 COUNSELLING

The first round of counselling will be common and conducted at JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round (s) of counselling will be held in respective Universities.

#### 7.9 Process of Counselling:

- 7.9.1 1st round of counselling shall be held at JIIT-Noida on 17-18 June 2025. Candidates are advised to check their email INBOX for the counselling intimation including the SPAM and JUNK Folder. Excuse regarding non-receipt of communication regarding counseling call shall not be entertained for claim of merit/ admission to the program at later date.
- **7.9.2** All candidates (including appearing in 10+2 examination in 2025) are required to upload their results on the application portal latest by the due date as specified in the Admission Calendar-2025.
- **7.9.3** Candidates called for counselling are permitted to exercise choice of only one University at the time of Counselling (No inter-university transfers are allowed).

- **7.9.4** Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE(Mains) 2025 AIR.
- **7.9.5** Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of any program/branches within the selected University (Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the same university, subject to availability of seats created against the withdrawals).
- 7.9.6 Seats in the programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of counselling.
- 7.9.7 During counselling a candidate can confirm the seat available or choose to be in waitlist by depositing Rs. 75000/- (seventy-five thousand). The amount will be adjusted against the Tuition fee of the first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- **7.9.8** Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/credit Card / UPI / Demand Draft favoring "Jaypee Institutes Admission Account" payable at Noida/Delhi. (Cheque and Cash are NOT acceptable.)
- **7.9.9** On allocation of a seat, candidate will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.

## Note:

- Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice form at the time of counselling.
- The candidates have the option of freezing confirmed seats allotted to them any time before upgradation is carried out, if they are satisfied with their allotted program/ branch and they do not want any further changes through up-gradation.

#### 7.10 COUNSELING (Second / Subsequent Rounds at JUIT, Waknaghat)

Counseling for Second/ Subsequent Rounds for specific admission to JUIT, Waknaghat will be held at JUIT, Waknaghat Campus on the dates stipulated in Admission Calendar of the University / dates notified on the Website of the University.

Candidates are advised to visit University website regularly for updates regarding counseling. All the communication regarding counseling will be done through the e-mail ID given in the Admission Form. Candidates are advised to check their E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder). Excuse regarding non-receipt of communication regarding counseling call shall not be entertained for claim of merit/ admission to the program at later date.

#### 7.11 Process of Offline Counseling:

- 7.11.1 Candidates as per merit list, who are called for Counseling, shall be allowed to exercise choice of the Branch at the time of Counseling itself. As this counseling is specific for admission to JUIT, Waknaghat. No inter- University transfers shall be allowed after allocation of seat.
- **7.11.2** Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of all branches within the university. Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs/ branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the University only.
- **7.11.3** Seats in the study of programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of Counseling, strictly in order of merit drawn based on Overall All India Rank of JEE (Main) 2025.
- **7.11.4** A candidate can confirm the seat available by depositing the Tuition fee and Admission charges (Rs. 160500/-+ Rs. 25000/- =Rs. 185500/-).
- 7.11.5 Candidates who have exercised single choice of branch and in case of non-availability of seat to the branch due to merit cut off, may keep themselves on pure wait listed for the branch by depositing total amount of Rs. 185500/- (Rs. 160500/- Tuition Fee + Rs. 25000/- admission charges) and such cases be considered for offer of admission subject to availability of seat to the program created due to vacancies against withdrawal and up-gradation.
- 7.11.6 Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ UPI/ Demand Draft favouring "Jaypee University of Information Technology" payable at Shimla.
- 7.11.7 Cheque and Cash is NOT acceptable.
- **7.11.8** After getting a seat and deposition of Tuition fee & non-refundable Admission charges, student will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.
- **7.11.9** The candidates shall have the option of freezing confirmed seats allotted to them any time before upgradation is carried out, if they do not want further up-gradation.

Note: Inter University transfer is not permissible. Candidates are advised to bring Demand Draft of the requisite amount in order to avoid last hour online payment issues. ## 8. ADMISSION PROCEDURE – 10+2 MARKS BASED BTECH PROGRAM UNDER NRI CATEGORY

- **8.1** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent examination in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are only eligible to apply for the program.
- 8.2 The merit shall be drawn, amongst the applications received under NRI / NRI sponsored category, based on the marks obtained in three subjects in 10+2 Examination as given in Section 4.1(d)(i) (For branches other than BT/BI) / 4.1(d) (ii) (For BT/BI branch) under General Eligibility Criteria.
- **8.3** Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail only. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional Admission offer letter through email. The candidates must therefore give their correct primary Email ID in their Application Form for communication.
- 8.4 Selected candidates have to deposit the applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges by the date given in the provisional admission offer letter to confirm seat to the program. In case of non-deposition of tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges by the stipulated date, the allotted seat will be offered to the next candidate in order of merit and earlier candidate has no right on the allotted seat until and unless candidate has taken time extension for depositing applicable tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges at later date. ## 9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - 10+2 MARKS (BIO) BASED BTECH PROGRAM IN BIOTECHNOLOGY / BIOINFORMATICS

- **9.1** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are only eligible to apply for the program.
- **9.2** Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as mentioned at **Section 4.1(d)(ii)** under General eligibility criteria should provide marks of the qualifying examination along with the application form and attach/ upload photo copy of the mark sheet.

- **9.3** For drawing merit of the candidates, three (03) subjects will be considered. Biology / Biotechnology as a compulsory subject along with any other two subjects having higher score out of Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subjects, Electronics, Entrepreneurship, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies and English.
- 9.4 Selection for admission to the program shall be on the basis of merit of (03) three subjects of the qualifying examination based on the scrutiny of applications. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional Admission offer letter through E-mail. All the correspondence related to selection / admission shall be made at the registered E-mail ID given in the Application Form only. Candidates are expected to check their given E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder). Candidates are also advised to visit University website for information related to admissions.
- **9.5** Candidates are expected to update their result / marks on the application portal well before the preparation of merit list. However, Result / Marks up-dation link for the candidates shall be sent to them well before the meriting of the applications through e-mail and candidates are expected to complete the process of marks updation well within the given time, failing which candidature for selection shall not be considered.
- **9.6** Claim of merit/ admission to the program shall not be considered at later date due to what so ever reason. However, such candidates shall be considered for admission to the program subject to availability of seat to the program.
- **9.7** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2025 should submit their results by the last date of application or prior to the meriting of the applications, whichever is earlier. Candidates who fail to submit 10+2 marksheet by the due date will not be considered for selection/admission.

- **10.3** The allocation of seat for admission to the program shall be based on merit through Counseling to be conducted at Jaypee University of Information Technology, Waknaghat for all eligible candidates.

- 10.4 For drawing merit of the candidates, three (03) subjects will be considered. Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English.
- 10.5 Candidates are advised to adhere to the schedule of the Counseling mentioned at Admission Calendar. All the correspondence related to counseling shall be made at the registered E-mail ID given in the Application Form only. Candidates are expected to check their given E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder). Candidates are also advised to visit University website for information related to counselling and admissions.
- 10.6 Claim of merit/admission to the program shall not be considered at later date due to what so ever reason. However, such candidates shall be considered for admission to the program in subsequent counselling(s) subject to availability of seat to the program.

- 6.1 Reservation for SC/ST/Kashmiri Migrant candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.

## 2. ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS (GENERAL)

- 2.1 Application forms for all programs in all categories of admission are available online at www.jaypeeu.ac.in and offline at the admission counter of the University. Application forms can also be downloaded from the University website.
- 2.2 If a candidate is applying for BTech Program under JEE (Main) 2025 category and also wants to apply under 10+2 marks based admission, the candidate must apply separately, however he/she is not required to pay additional application Fee of Rs. 1200/- to apply to BTech Program based on 10+2 Marks.
- **2.3** Applications received after the last date of submission will not be accepted and candidates shall have no claim on the merit list and subsequent admission to the program.
- **2.4** Candidates are required to check the website of the University for latest updates, and also take necessary action as per the information posted on the website.
- **2.5** Candidates are also advised to keep with them a copy of the mail along with the photocopy of the filledin Application Form. In any case, all issues regarding non receipt of Application form must be resolved before declaration of the merit list. No appeals thereafter will be entertained.
- **2.6** Candidates will be notified by e-mail to submit results of qualifying examination/eligibility criteria before the due date, failing which he/she will not be considered for the admission.

- 2.7 Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable academic fee. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail.

## 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- 6.1 Reservation for SC/ST candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all the programs.
- 6.2 For B.TECH admissions, 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on JEE (Main) 2025 All India Rank and remaining 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on merit, drawn on the basis of marks of 10+2 examination/CUET-UG.
- **6.3** 10% seats at Jaypee University, Anoopshahr are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel.
- 6.4 All vacant seats are inter-transferable in all categories

## 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURES – BTECH PROGRAMS (JEE MAIN 2025 AIR BASED)

- 7.1 Candidate's who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible to apply.
- **7.2** Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).
- **7.3** Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination and should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.
- 7.4 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship.
- **7.5** The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Main) 2025 AIR. Rank in no other category will be considered.
- **7.6 CHOICE(S) OF INSTITUTES/BRANCHES -** During counselling the candidate will need to select any one Institute/University and give choice for any/all the programs of that Institute/ University.

## 7.7 COUNSELLING INTIMATION:

- a) Counselling will be based on Merit. Candidates eligible for counselling on a specific date will be informed.
- **b)** Intimation will be sent by Email on registered mail ID's.
- c) Ignorance/lapses, if any, in participating in the allotted counselling slot shall not be accepted as an excuse to participate in counselling at a later date.

#### 7.8 COUNSELLING

The first round of counselling will be common and conducted at JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round (s) of counselling will be held in respective Universities.

#### **Process of Counselling:**

- a) 1st round of counselling shall be held at JIIT-Noida on 17-18 June 2025. Candidates are advised to check their Email for the counselling intimation.
- **b)** All candidates (including appearing in 10+2 examination in 2025) are required to upload their results on getadmissions portal latest by 05 June 2025.
- c) Candidates called for counselling are permitted to exercise choice of only one University at the time of Counselling (No inter-university transfers are allowed).
- d) Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE(Mains) 2025 AIR.
- e) Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of any program/branches within the selected University (Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the same university).
- f) Seats in the programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of counselling.
- g) During counselling a candidate can confirm the seat available or choose to be in wait list by depositing Rs. 75000/- (seventy-five thousand). The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- h) Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/credit Card / UPI / Demand Draft favoring "Jaypee Institutes Admission Account" payable at Noida/Delhi. (Cheque and Cash are NOT acceptable.)
- i) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.

- **8.1** The admission will be offered to the eligible candidates as per merit drawn based on aggregate percentage in the qualifying examinations as applicable to different programs.
- 8.2 All candidates who are offered provisional admission will be required to pay the advance fee for reservation of their seats (latest by the date as mentioned in the provisional admission offer letter), and produce proof of having passed the qualifying examination to the University authorities latest by September 30, 2025, failing which, such provisional admission will stand automatically cancelled. No representation for extension of dates, for whatsoever reasons, shall be entertained.
- **8.3** All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, the admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.
- **8.4** Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.

## 4. CONCESSION IN FEE FOR STUDENTS FROM JAYPEE SCHOOLS ADMITTED TO JAYPEE UNIVERSITY ANOOPSHAHR

- (a) The mentioned concession shall be applicable to the students of Jaypee Schools across Pan India whereas they shall be eligible for award of 10 % of concession in Tuition Fee as applicable to the respective programs/ Batches of their entry.
- (b) The above concession in Fee shall be applicable for 1st year only. The same may be continued in subsequent years (Minimum duration of the program) subject to achieving the minimum CGPA of 6 on a scale of 10 at the end of each academic year.
- (c) The above shall be applicable for the students admitted to Diploma and UG programs only.

## 5. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (PAYMENT OF FEE IN INSTALMENTS):

It has been observed that many of students are not able to pay their fees in advance for the semester whereas Jaypee University believes that money should not be barrier for students to pursue their studies.

Considering above, it is permitted to charge the fee from students (who are not able pay their fee in advance for the semester/year and having parent's income of less than Rs. 2.0 lakh per annum), on monthly basis. However the following criteria/terms & conditions are required to meet for the same:

- (a) The student must approach the University's authority requesting his/her inability to pay full fee in advance and accept the fee payment on monthly basis along with the submission of income certificate as required.
- (b) The payment of fee on monthly basis shall be applicable on Total Fee (except Caution Money and JYC Charges) which shall be divided by 10 and accordingly the fee dues shall be made for the concerned student on monthly basis.

## 6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The student shall be eligible for any one scholarship at a time (The option is to be finalized at time of admission) as given in Section 1 to 4.
- During the first semester, the student shall be required to pay the full fee however scholarship awarded for the first year will be considered/adjusted in the Fee dues for 2nd semester along with the regular scholarship of 1st semester as applicable.

## **11. REFUND POLICY**

- **11.1** The Application Fee is not refundable.
- **11.2** In case of withdrawal, the Academic Fee shall be refundable as per UGC/AICTE Norms. Last date of admission shall be notified/communicated as per the policy/instructions by regulatory bodies.
- 11.3 Refund of Hostel Charges:
  - Till the date of registration, a candidate is entitled for full refund of advance Hostel Charges, provided the student does not occupy the Hostel in advance.
  - From the Date of Registration in the program, the amount shall be refunded on pro-rata monthly basis, even if the student has not occupied the Hostel or not taken the key to the room.
  - For calculation of pro-rata charges, the duration of the semester shall be considered as five (5) months and deduction /refund shall be made on per month basis even if the hostel is occupied for part of a month i.e. even for a single day.
