The Chairperson welcomed the members including the external members who had joined the Academic Council Meeting in Online mode. The Chairman thanked the outgoing members and welcomed new members.

Due to Gulf war, JIIT is having its contingency planning and measures to be taken to ensure optimized utilization of the LPG and PNG supply from the Gas agencies.

He briefed about the works being undertaken by the Institute on the NCrF and NEP-2020. The Committees for the implementation have been notified.

The efforts undertaken by the Institute for improving its NIRF ranking were mentioned. He highlighted about the exercises being undertaken by the Depts for revisiting and revising the curricula of the various programs in consonance with the requirements of the Industry due to recent technological developments.

He informed about the reconstitution of the BoS of all the depts as per guidelines of the UGC for Deemed to be Universities.

ITEM-5: PHD ADMISSION PROCESS

The Academic council noted and approved the procedure, in consonance with the UGC guidelines, to be followed for admissions to PhD program in IIIT:

- (a) Shortlisting of applications – Applications received will be shortlisted, as per the eligibility criteria, for the admission process.
- (b) Written Test will be conducted for eligible candidates.
- (c) Interview will be conducted for applicants scoring minimum 50% marks in the written test.
- (d) Direct Interview will be held for UGC-NET (for PhD admission)/ CSIR/ SLET etc qualified candidates.
- (e) Merit List will be prepared with 70% weightage for written test score and 30% weightage for Interview (100% weightage for interview for direct interview category).
- (f) Admission will be offered as per the merit of the candidates and seats available in the program in different Depts.

ITEM-6: MOOCs ALLOCATION PROCESS

The Academic council noted the process being followed for implementing the MOOCs policy and allocations of the MOOC subjects to the students in IIIT:

- (a) 40% of the courses in a particular program can be offered through MOOCs.
- (b) The list of equivalent MOOC against the electives of the Semester will be prepared by Departmental MOOC coordinator(s).
- (c) Institute MOOC Coordinator gets list approved list for uploading on the website.
- (d) Student to register for MOOC subjects on the NPTEL portal.
- (e) Student to proceed for replacing the existing elective subject with the MOOC subject through the student web-portal.
- (f) Check and verification by Departmental MOOC coordinator.

- (g) Action by Institute MOOC Coordinator
 - (i) Collation of data from webportal
 - (ii) Approval of VC.
 - (iii) Allocation of subject to student.
- (h) MOOC for a 4/5 credit subject: In case a subject of 4/5 credits (i.e. more than 3 credits) is offered through MOOC, student will enroll in the nominated equivalent course of 3 credits on the NPTEL portal and the evaluation of the balance 1 or 2 credit will be done by the nominated Course Coordinator by assigning appropriate coursework such as assignments, project reports, paper publications, etc.

ITEM-7: AWARD OF 'F' (FAIL) GRADE ON OBTAINING MARKS LESS THAN 40 (AMENDMENT IN ACADEMIC SYSTEM OF ALL PROGRAMS).

The Academic Council approved the deferment of the decision "passing of a subject by the student on scoring 40 marks out of hundred i.e. student to be awarded Fail (F) Grade on scoring less than 40 Marks" from academic session 2025-26, to academic session 2026-27 (odd Sem 2026) onwards.

ITEM-8: MOUs SIGNED WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS

ITEM-11: REVIEW OF RESULTS OF ODD SEMESTER 2025

The Academic Council noted the results for Odd Sem 2025 and expressed satisfaction on the same.

ITEM-12: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO ONLINE PROGRAMS (CDOE)

The Academic Council approved the eligibility criteria for online programs applicable for admissions from session starting January 2026 onwards as follows:

- (a) **BBA** : Passed 10+2 examination with minimum 40% aggregate marks in any discipline and pass grade in all subjects.
- (b) **MBA** : Passed UG Degree of minimum 3 years duration in any discipline, with minimum 40% aggregate marks and pass grade in all subjects. Preference shall be given to candidates qualified any one of All India Tests i.e. CAT, XAT, CMAT, ATMA, MAT, GMAT, CUET (PG).
- (c) **BCA** : Passed 10+2 examination with minimum 40% aggregate marks in any discipline and pass grade in all subjects or pass in diploma in Commercial Practice or equivalent.
- (d) **MCA** : Passed BCA / bachelor's degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree or Passed BSc/BCom/BA with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level with minimum 40% aggregate marks and pass grade in all subjects.

ITEM-13: ANY OTHER ITEM WITH PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

A. Inclusion of revised POs and Course Mapping with Wks as per revised NBA Self Study Report.

As per the revised guidelines of the NBA for SSR, the number of Program outcomes (POs) has been reduced from 12 to 11. In addition the updated framework requires that the courses in the curriculum be mapped with the appropriate knowledge profiles (Wks) as defined in the Washington Accords Graduate Attributes Framework.

The Academic Council approved the same.

B. **Online MBA program aligned to 102 credits.** The Academic Council noted that CDOE had aligned the online MBA program to 102 credits, from AY 2025-26, which was in consonance with the UGC directions and MBA curricula as per AICTE. As the curricula for MBA was designed by the Jaypee Business School (JBS), this was approved as BoS minutes of JBS vide para-4 (O)(i) of Minutes of Academic Council Meeting held on 05 July 2025. This has been adopted by CDOE.
