## 2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The medium of instruction in the University is English.

### 2.2 Application Forms:

- (a) Application forms for all programs of admission are available online at [www.jiit.ac.in](http://www.jiit.ac.in). Apply online through the website in <https://getadmissions.com/jaypee> or collect offline forms from the admission counter of the University.
- (b) Candidates must ensure that mail ID and mobile phone number entered in the application form is continued till completion of admission process. All correspondence will be carried out on the registered email IDs. Mail ID once registered cannot be changed. Candidates are advised to use personal mail IDs and not to use corporate mail IDs.
- (c) If the APAAR (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) ID or ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) ID has been created by the applicant, the same maybe entered in the application form.
- (d) Follow the on-screen prompts to fill up the application form and make the payment through Credit card/Debit card/Net banking/UPI.
- (e) Once the payment is successful, an Application ID shall be allotted to the candidate, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation from [getadmissions.com](http://getadmissions.com).
- (f) During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and parent.
- (g) Candidates must carefully fill the choice of programs.
- (h) Candidates must check their application form carefully before final submission, as no change will be permitted after submitting the form. However, intimation will be sent to finalize choice of programs before the online counselling.
- (i) Candidates are advised to keep a copy of the application form for their reference.
- (j) Candidates can apply for more than one mode of admission. For example, if a candidate is applying under JEE (Main) 2026 category and also wants to apply under 10+2 basis or NRI category, the candidate must fill separate forms and pay the required application fee.
- (k) Candidates to ensure that results of 10+2/qualifying exam are uploaded before last date of application of the respective program.

2.3 Applications received after last date will not be accepted and candidates shall have no claim on the merit list and subsequent admission to the program.

2.4 The candidates are advised to check the website of the University for latest updates.

- 2.5 Display of Application Status: Candidates can view the receipt of their applications on the JIIT website within two working days of submission of the application form.
- 2.6 Candidates must have a pass result in all subjects in qualifying exam.
- 2.7 Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are eligible to apply for all UG programs.
- 2.8 Uploading of Documents: Candidate to upload clear copy of the required documents on the getadmissions portal before the scheduled date of counselling/admission.
- 2.9 Candidates to upload clear copy of the required documents, as applicable:
- (a) For UG Program: 10+2 mark sheet
  - (b) For BTech JEE Based application: JEE Mains scorecard mentioning the All India Rank (Upload the JEE Mains Final Score card with CRL and QR Code) alongwith 10+2 marksheet.
  - (c) Category wise candidates to upload the SC/ST certificate.
  - (d) Income certificate issued by State Government Authority for relevant scholarships.
  - (e) For PG Program: final year result or pre-final year/ semester mark sheet (for candidates appearing in qualifying examination in 2026).
  - (f) For BTech Lateral Entry Program: Final Semester Marksheet of UG degree/Diploma.

Note: Candidates appearing in qualifying exam in 2026 to upload final Sem/year marksheet before the last date of application.

**2.10** 2.10 Incomplete applications will not be considered.

2.11 Candidates will be considered for admission strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to verification of certificates of eligibility/qualification and depositing applicable academic fee.

2.12 All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original Certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, the admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.

2.13 Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.

2.14 For UG Program only: Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website) at the time of registration for the program.

2.15 Out of the seats available for counselling, 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on JEE Mains (AIR 2026) and 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on 10+2 marks merit.

2.16 Vacant seats are inter-transferable in either category i.e. JEE Mains AIR to 10+2 marks based or vice-versa.

2.17 JEE Application Only: While filling the JEE based application form for Jaypee Universities, candidates are advised to enter the same email id and mobile no. as mentioned in their NTA JEE Mains Application form.

2.18 Admission through Study in India (SII) Portal: As per instructions, received from Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, GOI, w.e.f. Academic Year 2026-27, it is mandatory for all foreign students coming for higher studies to India to mandatorily register on the SII Portal, and quote the Unique ID generated thereon in their visa applications. No foreign student would be able to get a student visa without registering on the SII Portal and quoting the Unique ID in the visa application.

**2.19** Link for counselling/admission portal:

- (a) Candidates offered admission/on waitlist will be sent the link of the counselling/admission portal on their registered email id's.
- (b) Candidates will be required to register/sign-in on the counselling/admission portal to view the details.
- (c) All updates will be displayed on this portal.
- (d) Fee Deposit/Hostel Request/Hostel Charges/Hostel Refund/Admission Withdrawal etc. to be executed through the admission/counselling portal ONLY.

## 5. RESERVATION OF SEATS

5.1 Reservation for SC/ST candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.

### **BTech & Integrated MTech Program:**

5.2 **Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW):** 2% seats in BTech program shall be offered under TFW scheme. Seats will be allocated on merit. Candidates with family income less than 8 lakhs per annum are eligible. Valid Income Certificate issued by the State Authorities will be accepted.

5.3 **Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS):** 2 seats per BTech Program at JIIT, Noida are reserved for J&K students under this scheme.

5.4 Concession for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/Kashmiri Hindu Families (non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission at JIIT Noida will be as per MHRD letter No. 3-4/2017-NER dated October 15, 2019.

## 6. BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH (JEE BASED) (ONLINE COUNSELLING)

### 6.1 Eligibility:

- (a) Passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate.
- (b) Secured pass grade in all subjects.

6.2 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, and Entrepreneurship.

6.3 The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Mains) AIR 2026. Rank in no other category will be considered.

6.4 **COUNSELLING INTIMATION:** Counselling will be based on Merit. Shortlisted candidates eligible for counselling will be informed by email on registered mail ID's. List of candidates will also be uploaded in the website.

6.5 **COUNSELLING:** The first round of counselling will be common and conducted by JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round(s) of counselling will be conducted by respective Universities.

### 6.6 Process of Counselling:

- (a) The counselling will be held in online mode.
- (b) All applicants to upload their JEE Mains results on getadmissions portal as per the schedule of counselling. Candidates are also required to upload the 10+2 marksheet.
- (c) Eligible candidates if desirous, will have the option to amend/update their choices before the scheduled counselling date.
- (d) Initial Fees of Rs. 60000/- (sixty thousand) to be deposited. The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (e) Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE (Mains) AIR 2026 and as per the preferences indicated in the choice form.
- (f) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be sent Provisional Admission Letter. The communication will be sent to registered email id and mobile number. The details will be also visible in the candidate's counselling portal.
- (g) The candidate should pay the balance fees as mentioned in the offer letter within the due date to confirm the admission.
- (h) The candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them.

**Note:**

1. Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice(s) before submitting their choice form.
2. Instructions regarding detailed conduct of counselling will be updated on the website as per counselling schedule.
3. Only the candidates, who have uploaded clear copy (should include the CRL (Common Rank List) and (QR Code) of the JEE Main-2026 in their application form, will be considered for counselling.

## 7. BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH (10+2 MARKS BASED) (ONLINE COUNSELLING)

**7.1 Eligibility:**

- (a) Passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate.
- (b) Secured pass grade in all subjects

**7.2** The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, and Entrepreneurship.

**7.3** Merit will be prepared on marks scored in Maths, Physics (both compulsory subjects) & one subject as mentioned in Para 7.2 above.

**7.4** Eligible candidates will be informed about the online counselling as per merit and candidates are advised to check their email for the counselling intimation. Counselling intimation will be as mentioned in Para 6.4 above.

**7.5** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination in the year 2026 are responsible for uploading their results on get admissions portal at least one week before the scheduled date of counselling.

**7.6** Applications with incomplete documents/results of 10+2 will not be considered for counselling.

**7.7 Process of Counselling:**

- (a) The counselling will be held in online mode.
- (b) Eligible candidates if desirous, will have the option to amend/update their choices before the scheduled counselling date.
- (c) Initial Fees of Rs. 60000/- (sixty thousand) to be deposited. The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (d) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be sent Provisional Admission Letter. The communication will be sent to registered email id and mobile number. The details will be also visible in the candidate's counselling portal.
- (e) The candidate should pay the balance fees as mentioned in the offer letter within the due date to confirm the admission.
- (f) Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them.

2. Instructions regarding detailed conduct of counselling will be updated on the website as per counselling schedule.

8.4 Admission Process:

- The counselling will be held in online mode.
- Candidates, filling the 10+2 application form for BTech admissions at JIIT, will have the option to apply for Program Specific Admission.
- There is No separate / additional application fee.
- Separate application number (DAG26xxxx) will be generated.
- Candidates, as per merit, will be informed of online counselling for admission to the above programs. Merit list will be prepared as per details in para 7.2 & 7.3 above.
- A candidate can apply for only one of the programs when giving the final choice for the admission process.
- Candidates after finalizing their choice must deposit Rs. 60000/- (Sixty Thousand). The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester.
- After getting a seat student will be offered Provisional Admission Letter which will be visible in the candidates counselling portal. The communication will also be sent to registered email id and mobile number.
- Admissions will be offered only against available seats. There will be No waiting list.
- Candidate confirming admission (on deposition of fees) will not be eligible for admission under any other category of BTech/Integrated MTech program. Their candidature will accordingly be removed from all other BTech programs at JIIT.
- No change of program/branch is allowed after admission is confirmed.

## 9. ADMISSION BTECH AND INTEGRATED MTECH IN BIOTECHNOLOGY (10+2 MARKS BASED)

9.1 Eligibility:

- Passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and any one subject out of Biology, Biotechnology, Mathematics.
- Candidates should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.

9.2 Admission Process:

- The counselling will be held in online mode.
- The admission will be offered to the candidates as per the merit. The selected candidates will be notified by Email.
- Merit will be prepared on marks scored in Physics, Chemistry (both compulsory subjects) & one subject as mentioned in Para 9.1(a) above.
- Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination must upload their results at least one week before the scheduled date of counselling.

**Note:** Candidates may also apply on the basis of JEE Mains AIR 2026.

## 10. ADMISSION IN NRI/NRI SPONSORED CATEGORY

NRI stands for Non-Resident Indian, referring to an Indian citizen who resides outside India for work, business, education, or due to other reasons.

### 10.1 Eligibility:

- (a) Passed in all subjects in 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum aggregate of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in the year 2024, 2025 or appearing in year 2026.
- (b) Consideration of Subjects for Merit: Physics, Mathematics, Biology, Biotechnology, Chemistry, computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subjects, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Entrepreneurship, Business Studies.
- (c) Merit for BTech (Non-Biotech Programs): - Physics, Mathematics are compulsory subjects and one other subject from the list above (highest score will be considered).
- (d) Merit for BTech Biotechnology Program: - Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and any one subject out of Biology, Biotechnology or Mathematics.
- (e) The selected candidates will be informed through e-mail. The candidate must therefore mention the correct primary email ID.

### 10.2 Admission Procedure:

- (a) Eligible candidates will be offered provisional admission on merit, subject to meeting the qualifying requirements and deposition of Institutional Fee within the specified dates mentioned in the offer letter.
- (b) The selected candidates will be informed through e-mails. The candidate must therefore mention the correct primary email ID for faster processing.
- (c) The candidates will be informed to submit the following documents:
  - 10+2 or equivalent board mark sheet to be uploaded.
  - Sponsorship letter from NRI, (sponsoring the candidate) as per proforma which can be downloaded from the website.
  - Sponsor's passport copy.
- (d) Candidates granted admission under this category cannot opt for change to General category in subsequent years. However, candidates can apply for different category of admission (eg, JEE(Main), 10+2 Merit) by filling separate application forms as applicable.

## 11. LATERAL ENTRY/DIRECT ADMISSION TO 2ND YEAR BTECH PROGRAM

**11.1 Eligibility:** The candidates should have passed the following in 2025 or appearing in 2026:

- (a) Passed three years Diploma with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in the same branch in which admission in BTech 2nd year is sought and minimum aggregate 60% in class 10th / 12th (as applicable).
- (b) Passed BSc in Science subjects (Mathematics compulsory) with at least 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) or equivalent CGPA from a recognized university.
- (c) Passed BVoc/3 Years of DVoc stream in the same or allied sector.

Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) and should have secured overall Pass grade and pass grade in mandatory subjects, if any for any particular program of admission.
- (b) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BTech Program, will be required to submit Gap Period affidavit as per the format available at University Website.
- (c) For JEE (Mains) based admission, candidates should have qualified JEE (Mains) – 2026 All India Rank (AIR) and should have passed or appeared in 10+2 Examination or equivalent (as defined in JEE (Mains) 2026) from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English from any recognized Board with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks.
- (d) For 10+2 marks-based admissions, candidates should have passed 10+2 examination or its equivalent examination with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ ST) in aggregate or equivalent grade from the Boards recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE).
  - (i) 10+2 marks based (Non-JEE Candidates) for admission in branches other than Biotechnology / Bioinformatics: The candidate should have minimum of 60% aggregate marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English. Candidate should have pass grade in the mandatory subjects as defined above.

- (ii) 10+2 marks based (Non-JEE Candidates) for admission in Biotechnology /Bioinformatics Program: The candidate should have minimum of 60% aggregate marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) with Biology/ Biotechnology as compulsory subjects along with two subjects out of Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subjects, Electronics, Entrepreneurship, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies and English. Candidate should have pass grade in the mandatory subjects as defined above.

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (UG) 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.2 BTech (Lateral Entry) Directly to 2nd Year** – The candidate should have passed / appeared (in final semester/ year) 03 Year Diploma Program with 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or its equivalent CGPA from recognized Board / University.

**OR**

Candidates who have passed BTech 1st Year Examination with 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or its equivalent CGPA from the recognized University / Institutions are also eligible for admission to the Program.

- 4.3 BBA Program** – Candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or equivalent grade from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE).

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (UG) 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.4 BCA Program** – Candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with minimum 55% (50% for SC/ST) aggregate marks or equivalent grade from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE).

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (UG) 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.5 BSc Program** - The candidate should have passed 10+2 examination from Boards recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) with minimum of 60% aggregate marks (55% for SC/ST) or its equivalent grade with Physics and Chemistry as a compulsory subject along with one subject out of Biology / Mathematics. Candidate should have pass grade in the mandatory subjects as defined above.

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (UG) – 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.6 MSc Program in Biotechnology, Microbiology –**

- 4.6.1 Non DBT Biotechnology/ Microbiology** – Candidate should have passed BSc (Hons)/ BSc or an equivalent Undergraduate Degree in any branch of Life Sciences/ Medical Sciences/ any branch of Biology under 10+2+3 pattern securing 50% aggregate marks (45%for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in aggregate. Candidates having CGPA  $\geq 7.5$  or equivalent percentage in qualifying examination will be considered for direct admission to MSc Program.

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (PG) - 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.6.2 DBT Supported MSc Biotechnology** – 10 Seats of MSc (Biotechnology) program are supported by DBT and admission to such seats is through Qualified Rank of GAT-B-2026 in order of merit.

- 4.7 MTech Program** – Candidate should have passed four-year Bachelor's degree in the relevant discipline with minimum 60% (55% for SC/ST) marks or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in aggregate from a recognized University / Institution. Admission is through PGET (PG Entrance Test) conducted by Jaypee University of Information Technology. The condition of admission on the basis of merit of PGET Test for candidates having CGPA  $\geq 7.5$  or equivalent percentage in qualifying examination has been relaxed and such candidates will be offered direct admission to the MTech Program. GATE Qualified candidates are exempted from PGET Entrance Test. However, they have to appear for the interview.

**OR**

Candidates having qualified CUET (PG) – 2026 Rank / Score in the relevant discipline are also eligible for admission to the program.

- 4.8 MBA Program** - Graduate in any discipline with 50% aggregate marks (45% for SC/ST) or equivalent CGPA score from the recognized Institute / University. Admission is through the Entrance Test (JMAT) conducted by the University and performance in GD/PI.

**OR**

Candidates having CAT/MAT/CMAT/XAT/GMAT/ATMA/CUET-PG qualifying Rank/ Score. Such candidates are exempted from the Entrance Test (JMAT) and admission will be in order of merit of the relevant National level exam and performance in GD/PI conducted by the University.

**4.9 PhD Program – 1-Year / 2-Semester (or 2-year/4-semester) Master’s Degree program after a 4-year / 8-Semester Bachelor’s Degree program with at least 60% marks in aggregate or CGPA not less than 06 on scale of 10.**

**OR**

A 2-Year / 4-Semester Master’s Degree program after a 3-year Bachelor’s Degree program with at least 60% marks in aggregate or CGPA not less than 06 on scale of 10.

**OR**

A 4-Year / 8-Semester Bachelor’s Degree program with 75% aggregate marks or CGPA not less than 7.5 on scale of 10.

Consistently good academic record / performance is desirable

Selection will be based on the PhD Entrance test (PGET) followed by interview conducted by Jaypee University of Information Technology. NET/ SLET/ UGC/ CSIR (JRF) candidates are exempted from the PhD Entrance Test but have to appear for the interview.

#### **General to all Programs**

- All candidates who are offered provisional admission will be required to produce proof of having passed the qualifying examination to the University authorities latest by September 30, 2026 failing which, such provisional admission will stand automatically cancelled. No representation for extension of dates, for whatsoever reasons, shall be entertained.
- All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, his/ her admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.
- Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate. Application Fee is non-refundable and request for refund of application fee shall be summarily rejected in case of candidate not found eligible for admission to the program.
- Candidates appearing in qualifying examinations prescribed above in the year 2026 can also apply for admission. However, admission is based on marks merit, the result must be submitted before the preparation of merit as per admission calendar 2026. Candidates who fail to submit their result at the time of preparation of merit list may be considered for admission at the later stage subject to availability of the seat to the program and on submission of result of the qualifying examination.

**5.1.3** Once the payment has been successfully made, the candidate shall be allotted an Application ID, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation.

**5.1.4** During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and the parent.

## 7. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- 7.1** Reservation for SC/ST/ candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.
- 7.2** For admissions in BTech (Biotechnology and Bioinformatics) programs, 50% seats shall be filled on the basis of JEE (Main) 2026 All India Rank and balance 50% seats shall be filled on the basis of 10+2 marks with Biology/ Biotechnology as core subject in 10+2 examination. However, seats are inter-transferable in either category considering number of applications to each category.
- 7.3** For admissions in BTech (Other than Biotechnology / Bioinformatics) programs, 50% seats shall be allotted through JEE (Main) 2026 All India Rank and balance 50% seats shall be filled through Counseling based on merit, drawn on the basis of marks of 10+2 examination. However, seats are inter-transferable in either category considering number of applications to each category.
- 7.4** 10% seats at JUIT, Wagnaghat for BTech programs only are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel. 30% concession in Tuition Fee for wards of serving and retired

Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel will be provided to candidates admitted under such category only. Additional 5% concession (i.e. 35%) in Tuition Fee will be provided for wards of War Widows and personnel killed in action or persons with disability during the services.

- 7.5 10% seats at JUIT, Wagnaghat are reserved for Himachal Pradesh (HP) category candidates subject to the condition that candidate has qualified the 10+2 examination from any of the schools/Institutions located in the State of Himachal Pradesh. Merely holding the Himachal bonafide certificate does not entitle for admission under the Himachal Pradesh (HP) Category.
- 7.6 Reservation for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non- Migrants) living in Kashmir valley as per MHRD letter No. 3-4/2017-NER dated October 15, 2019.
- 7.7 Supernumerary seats for candidates who have been issued with PM CARES for Children Scheme Certificate – 2021.

## 8. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - JEE MAIN 2026 ALL INDIA RANK BASED BTECH PROGRAM (ONLINE COUNSELLING)

### 8.1 Eligibility:

- (a) Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam from the Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education India (COBSE) in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 with minimum 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) aggregate.
  - (b) Secured pass grade in all subjects.
- 8.2 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English.
- 8.3 The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Mains) AIR 2026. Rank in no other category will be considered.
- 8.4 **COUNSELLING INTIMATION:** Counselling will be based on merit. Shortlisted candidates eligible for counselling will be informed by email on registered mail ID's. List candidates will also be uploaded in the website.
- 8.5 **COUNSELLING:** The first round of counselling will be common and conducted by JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Wagnaghat, JUET-Gune and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round(s) of counselling will be conducted by respective Universities.

### 8.6 Process of Counselling:

- (a) The counselling will be held in online mode.
- (b) All applicants to upload their JEE Mains results on getadmissions portal as per the schedule of counselling. Candidates are also required to upload the 10+2 marksheet.
- (c) Eligible candidates if desirous, will have the option to amend/update their choices before the scheduled counselling date.
- (d) Initial Fees Rs. 60,000/- (Sixty thousand) to be deposited. The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- (e) Allocation of seats will be as per merit of JEE (Mains) AIR 2026 and as per the preferences indicated in the choice form.
- (f) On allocation of a seat, candidates will be sent Provisional Admission Letter. The communication will be sent to registered email ID and mobile number. The details will be also visible in the candidate's counselling portal.
- (g) The candidate should pay the balance fees as mentioned in the offer letter within the due date to confirm the admission.
- (h) The candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs / branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them.

**Note:**

1. Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice(s) before submitting their choice form.
2. Instructions regarding detailed conduct of counselling will be updated on the website as per counselling schedule.
3. Only the candidates, who have uploaded clear copy (should include the CRL (Common Rank List) and (QR Code) of the JE Mains-2026 in their application form, will be considered for counselling.

**8.7 COUNSELING (Second / Subsequent Rounds at JUIT, Wagnaghat)**

- 8.7.1 Counseling for Second/ Subsequent Rounds for specific admission to JUIT, Wagnaghat will be held at JUIT, Wagnaghat Campus on the dates to be notified on the University Website. Counselling dates will be notified on the University Website and shall be conveyed to the prospective applicants through e-mail communication on the registered e-mail ID mentioned in the application form.
- 8.7.2 Candidates are advised to visit University website regularly for updates regarding counseling. All the communication regarding counseling will be done through the e-mail ID given in the Admission Form.
- 8.7.3 Candidates are advised to check their E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder).
- 8.7.4 Excuse regarding non- receipt of communication regarding counseling call shall not be entertained for claim of merit/ admission to the program at later date.

**8.8 Process of Offline Counseling:**

- 8.8.1 Candidates as per merit list, who are called for Counseling, shall be allowed to exercise choice of the Branch at the time of Counseling itself. As this counseling is specific for admission to JUIT, Wagnaghat. No inter- University transfers shall be allowed after allocation of seat.
- 8.8.2 Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of all branches within the university. Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs/ branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the University only.
- 8.8.3 Seats in the study of programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of Counseling, strictly in order of merit drawn based on Overall All India Rank of JEE (Main) 2026.
- 8.8.4 A candidate can confirm the seat available by depositing the Tuition fee and Admission charges (Rs. 164550/- + Rs. 25000/- =Rs. 189550/-).
- 8.8.5 Candidates who have exercised single choice of branch and in case of non-availability of seat to the branch due to merit cut off, may keep themselves on pure wait listed for the branch by depositing total amount of Rs. 189550/- (Rs. 164550/- Tuition Fee + Rs. 25000/- admission charges) and such cases be considered for offer of admission subject to availability of seat to the program created due to vacancies against withdrawal and up-gradation.
- 8.8.6 Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ UPI/ Demand Draft favouring "Jaypee University of Information Technology" payable at Shimla / Solan.
- 8.8.7 Cheque and Cash is NOT acceptable.
- 8.8.8 After getting a seat and deposition of Tuition fee & non-refundable Admission charges, student will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.
- 8.8.9 The candidates shall have the option of freezing confirmed seats allotted to them any time before up-gradation is carried out, if they do not want further up-gradation.

**Note: Inter University transfer is not permissible. Candidates are advised to bring Demand Draft of the requisite amount for physical counselling in order to avoid last hour online payment issues. In case of online payment, they are advised to check their daily credit limit before attending counselling. Being merit-based counselling, in the event of non-deposition of the Tuition Fee & Admission Charges, seat will be offered to the next candidate in order of merit.**

## 9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE – 10+2 MARKS BASED BTECH PROGRAM UNDER NRI CATEGORY

- 9.1 Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent examination in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are only eligible to apply for the program.
- 9.2 The merit shall be drawn, amongst the applications received under NRI / NRI sponsored category, based on the marks obtained in three subjects in 10+2 Examination as given in **Section 4.1 (d) (i) (For branches other than BT/BI) / 4.1 (d) (ii) (For BT/BI branch)** under General Eligibility Criteria.
- 9.3 Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail only. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional Admission offer letter through email. The candidates must therefore give their correct primary Email ID in their Application Form for communication.
- 9.4 Selected candidates have to deposit the applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges by the date given in the provisional admission offer letter to confirm seat to the program. In case of non-deposition of tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges by the stipulated date, the allotted seat will be offered to the next candidate in order of merit and earlier candidate has no right on the allotted seat until and unless candidate has taken time extension for depositing applicable tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges at later date. All time extension for deposition of tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges be addressed to Registrar at e-mail ID: registrar@juit.ac.in
- 9.5 Fees remittance instructions shall be conveyed through the Provisional Admission letter.
- 9.6 Candidates who have taken admission under this category can not opt for change to General/ Non-NRI category in subsequent years of the entire program duration.
- 9.7 NRI Application Form is specific to the University; accordingly separate Application Forms should be filled for each University.
- 9.8 Those who have already passed 10+2 examination in 2024 & 2025 should fill 10+2 marks in the application form and upload /attach a photocopy of the marks sheet.
- 9.9 Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2026 should submit their results by the last date of application. Candidates who fail to submit their 10+2 marksheet by the due date will not be considered for admission.
- 9.10 All candidates should compulsorily attach Sponsorship Letter from NRI or NRI certificate, as the case may be, along with the application form. Format of Sponsorship letter is available on Admission Page of JUIT website.
- 9.11 In case of offline application form, the completed Application Form must be deposited or sent to the Admission Cell, Jaypee University of Information Technology, P.O. Wagnaghat, Teh. Kandaghat, Distt. Solan. On the top of the envelope, please mention 'Application under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category.

## 10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - 10+2 MARKS (BIO) BASED BTECH PROGRAM IN BIOTECHNOLOGY / BIOINFORMATICS

- 10.1 Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are only eligible to apply for the program.
- 10.2 Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as mentioned at **Section 4.1 (d) (ii)** under General eligibility criteria should provide marks of the qualifying examination along with the application form and attach/ upload photo copy of the mark sheet.
- 10.3 For drawing merit of the candidates, three (03) subjects will be considered. Biology / Biotechnology as a compulsory subject along with any other two subjects having higher score out of Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subjects, Electronics, Entrepreneurship, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies and English.

**10.4** Selection for admission to the program shall be on the basis of merit of (03) three subjects of the qualifying examination based on the scrutiny of applications. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional Admission offer letter through E-mail. All the correspondence related to selection / admission shall be made at the registered E-mail ID given in the Application Form only. Candidates are expected to check their given E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder). Candidates are also advised to visit University website for information related to admissions.

**10.5** Candidates are expected to update their result / marks on the application portal well before the preparation of merit list. However, Result / Marks up-dation link for the candidates shall be sent to them well before the meriting of the applications through e-mail and candidates are expected to complete the process of marks up-dation well within the given time, failing which candidature for selection shall not be considered.

**10.6** Claim of merit/ admission to the program shall not be considered at later date due to what so ever reason. However, such candidates shall be considered for admission to the program in subsequent counselling (s) subject to availability of seat to the program.

**10.7** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2026 should submit their results by the last date of application or prior to the meriting of the applications, whichever is earlier. Candidates who fail to submit 10+2 marksheet by the due date will not be considered for selection/admission.

#### **10.8 ALLOCATION OF SEATS**

**10.8.1** Candidates have to mark choices of branches in order of priority while filling the online / offline application form. Candidates are advised to mark priority of the branch judiciously as the choices mentioned in the admission form will not be changed at later stage and allocation of seat will be in order of merit and priority of choices.

**10.8.2** Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges.

**10.8.3** Selected candidates have to deposit the applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges by the date given in the provisional admission offer letter to confirm seat to the program. In case of non-deposition of tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges by the stipulated date, the allotted seat will be offered to the next candidate in order of merit and earlier candidate has no right on the allotted seat until and unless candidate has taken time extension for depositing applicable tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges at later date. All time extension for deposition of tuition fee and non-refundable admission charges be addressed to Registrar at e-mail ID: registrar@juit.ac.in

#### **10.9 Admission Process (CUET-UG-2026 Basis)**

National Testing Agency is conducting CUET-UG-2026. Merit list of the applicants who have applied for BTech Program on the basis of CUET-UG-2026 qualified Rank / Marks shall be prepared and admission offer in order of merit will be given to the candidates who have confirmed their seat to the program by paying applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges.

**Note: Inter University transfer is not permissible.**

## **11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - 10+2 MARKS BASED BTECH PROGRAM**

**11.1** Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are only eligible to apply for the program.

**11.2** Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as mentioned at **Section 4.1 (d) (i)** under General eligibility Criteria should provide marks of the qualifying examination along with the application form and attach photocopy of the mark sheet.

**11.3** The allocation of seat for admission to the program shall be based on merit through Counseling to be conducted at Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wakanaghat for all eligible candidates.

**11.4** For drawing merit of the candidates, three (03) subjects will be considered. Physics and Mathematics as

compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English.

- 11.5** Candidates are advised to adhere to the schedule of the Counseling mentioned at Admission Calendar / published on the University Website. All the correspondence related to counseling shall be made at the registered E-mail ID given in the Application Form only. Candidates are expected to check their given E-mail regularly (including Spam/ Junk Folder). Candidates are also advised to visit University website for information related to counselling and admissions.
- 11.6** Claim of merit/admission to the program shall not be considered at later date due to what so ever reason. However, such candidates shall be considered for admission to the program in subsequent counselling(s) subject to availability of seat to the program.
- 11.7** Candidates are expected to update their result / marks on the application portal well before the preparation of merit / counselling, whichever is applicable. However, Result / Marks up-dation link for the candidates shall be sent to the candidates well before the meriting of the applications through e-mail and candidates are expected to complete the process of marks up-dation well within the given time, failing which candidature for selection shall not be considered.
- 11.8** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2026 should submit their results by the last date of application or prior to the meriting of the applications, whichever is earlier. Candidates who fail to submit 10+2 marksheet by the due date will not be considered for counselling and thereof for admission to the program. However, they may considered for subsequent round of Counselling(s), subject to availability of seat to the program.

#### **11.9 ALLOCATION OF SEATS**

- 11.9.1** Candidates have to exercise choice of the branch during the process of the Counselling itself. Candidates are advised to mark priority of the branch judiciously as the choices given in the choice proforma will not be changed at later stage and allocation of seat will be in order of merit and priority of choices. Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of all branches within the university. Thus, the candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the University only. However, upgradation is subject to availability of seats created due to withdrawals.
- 11.9.2** Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges.
- 11.9.3** The candidate selected for admission to the program during the counseling has to deposit the Tuition Fee and non-refundable admission charges amounting to Rs. 189550/- (Tuition Fee Rs.164550/- + Admission Charges Rs. 25000/-) instant during the counseling itself to confirm their seat to the program. In case of non-payment of Tuition Fee amount and non-refundable admission charges, the said allocation of the seat will be done to the next candidate in order of merit.
- 11.9.4** Candidates who have exercised single choice of branch and in case of non-availability of seat to the branch due to merit cut off, may keep themselves on pure wait listed for the branch by depositing total amount of Rs. 189550/- (Tuition Fee Rs. 164550/- + Admission charges Rs. 25000/-) and such cases be considered for offer of admission subject to availability of seat to the program created due to vacancies against withdrawal and up-gradation.
- 11.9.5** Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ UPI/ Demand Draft favouring “Jaypee University of Information Technology” payable at Shimla.
- 11.9.6** Cheque and Cash is NOT acceptable.
- 11.9.7** After getting a seat and deposition of Tuition fee & non-refundable Admission charges, student will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.
- 11.9.8** The candidates shall have the option of freezing confirmed seats allotted to them any time before up-gradation is carried out, if they do not want further up-gradation.

**Note: Inter University transfer is not permissible. Candidates are advised to bring Demand Draft of the requisite amount for physical counselling in order to avoid last hour online payment issues. In case of online payment, they are advised to check their daily credit limit before attending counselling. Being merit-based counselling, in the event of non-deposition of the Tuition Fee & Admission Charges, seat will be offered to the next candidate in order of merit.**

- One Scholarship in all BTech Programs considering all streams / branches.
- Combined income of parent should be less than Rs. 8.0 lac per annum.
- Merit list prepared in the second semester considering student's marks in class 10th (15% weightage), class 12th (35% weightage) and result of BTech 1st Semester (50% weightage).
- Scholarship is awarded in Even Semester every year.

**(e) Teaching Assistantship to MTech Students**

- Teaching Assistantship of Rs. 15000/- per month (05 months in a semester) is paid to the GATE qualified candidates.
- Non-GATE qualified candidates having CGPA  $\geq 7.50$  or equivalent marks in qualifying degree at the time of admission will be given TA of Rs. 15000/- per month (05 months in a semester) for the first semester. Continuation of TA to the subsequent semester is subject to CGPA  $\geq 7.5$  in the previous semester.
- For GATE qualified candidates, TA is applicable from the date of Registration. However, for Non-GATE candidates, TA is applicable from 1st October of the admission year.

**(f) Fellowship to PhD Scholars**

Fellowship of Rs. 45,000/- per month is paid to the full time PhD scholars for the maximum duration of three years. However, continuation of fellowship to 5th semester is subject to conditions stipulated in JUIT Ordinance / Fellowship Rules.

## 4. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

### 4.1 B Tech Programs :

- a) Candidates who have passed 10+2/Equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are eligible to apply.
- b) The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent (as defined in JEE (Main) 2026 examination) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English. For Civil Engineering/Chemical Engineering/Mechanical Engineering Programs, Chemistry is must with Physics and Mathematics.
- c) Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination. Other conditions at 4.1(a) and 4.1(b) will remain same.
- d) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BTech will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in).
- e) Seats will be filled through Counselling based on JEE (mains) AIR (2026). Any remaining seats will be filled through university level Counselling based on 10+2 results.

### 4.2 BTech Programs (Lateral Entry):

- a. Passed Diploma in engineering with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) OR
- b. Passed BTech 1st Year from a recognized University as defined by UGC , with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) or equivalent CGPA in the same branch in which admission in BTech 2nd year is sought. OR
- c. Passed BSc Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ ST) and passed 10+2 with mathematics as a subject. OR
- d. Passed B.VOC/ 3-year D.VOC Stream in the same or allied sector in the same discipline.

### 4.3 BBA Program:

- a. Candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized educational board.
- b. Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BBA will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in).

**4.4 Diploma Program** - Candidate should have passed or appeared in 2026 in 10th or equivalent examination from a recognized educational board with Science and Mathematics as subjects. For direct entry into 2nd year Diploma, candidates should have passed ITI in relevant branch or passed 10+2 examination with Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics/Computer Science/Electronics/IT.

**4.5 MSc Program** – Candidates should have passed BSc (Hons)/BSc under 10+2+3 pattern securing the minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10-point scale in the aggregate in science subjects (considering all the three years of BSc course). The subject in which admission is sought must be the Hons. subject at BSc (Hons.) Level/ a subject studied in all three years at undergraduate level.

**4.6 MTech Program** – Candidates should have passed BE/BTech examination with 60% marks or 6.0 CGPA on 10-point scale in the relevant discipline.

**4.7 PhD Program** – PG degree with 55% (50% for SC/ST) marks from a recognized University/Institution in the relevant subject in regular mode. Admission will be based on the PhD entrance test followed by interview conducted at JUET, Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in the PhD Entrance test but will have to appear in the interview.

**4.8** All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, his/her admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.

- (b) Eligible candidates, if desirous, will have option to amend/update their choices. NRI stands for Non-Resident Indian, referring to an Indian citizen who resides outside India for work, business, education, or due to other reasons.

## 9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE – 10+2 MARKS BASED B T.ECH ADMISSION UNDER NRI CATEGORY

- 9.1 The merit shall be drawn amongst the applications received under NRI /NRI sponsored category based on the marks obtained in three subjects in 10+2 as given in Section 4.1 (b) under General Eligibility Criteria.
- 9.2 Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Academic fee. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail by the respective Universities. The candidate must therefore give their correct primary Email ID for communication.
- 9.3 Candidates who take admission under this category cannot opt for change to General/ Non-NRI category in subsequent years of the entire program duration.
- 9.4 Those who have already passed 10+2 examination should fill 10+2 marks in the application form and Attach a photocopy of the marks sheet.
- 9.5 Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2026 should submit their results by the last date of application. Candidates who fail to submit their 10+2 marks sheet by the due date will not be considered for admission.
- 9.6 All candidates should compulsorily attach Sponsorship Letter from NRI or NRI certificate, as the case May be, along with the application form.
- 9.7 In case of offline application form, the completed application form must be submitted or sent to the University on the address given in para 5.3(d) above. On the top of the envelope, please mention “Application under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category”

## 10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE-LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION TO 2ND YEAR B.TECH PROGRAM

Based on the applications received and meeting the eligibility criteria, merit shall be prepared based on CGPA/ Marks obtained in Diploma/B Tech 1st year/ BSc/ D. Voc Admission shall be offered based on the merit.

## 11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - DIPLOMA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - MSC PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered Provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 13. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - M.TECH PROGRAM

Candidates meeting the eligibility criteria will be required to appear in the PGET conducted by JUET, Guna. A merit will be drawn based on marks obtained in PGET. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee. GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PGET.

## 14. ADMISSION PROCEDURE PHD PROGRAM

Admission to PhD Program will be done through PhD Entrance Test followed by interview conducted by JUET Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PhD Entrance Test. However, they will be required to appear for the interview conducted by the respective department. Admission will be offered purely on the basis of PhD Entrance Test Result and/or Interview. The admission will be provisional and subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of academic fee.

## 15. ADMISSION PROCEDURE BBA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn based on marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates shall be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

6.1 Reservation for SC/ST candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all the programs.

6.2 For B.TECH admissions, 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on JEE (Main) 2025 All India Rank and remaining 50% seats shall be filled through counselling based on merit, drawn on the basis of marks of 10+2 examination/CUET-UG.

6.3 10% seats at Jaypee University, Anoopshahr are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel.

6.4 All vacant seats are inter-transferable in all categories

## 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURES – BTECH PROGRAMS (JEE MAIN 2026 AIR BASED)

- 7.1 Candidates who have passed 10+2/equivalent exam in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026 are eligible to apply.
- 7.2 Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to UG programs will be required to submit a Gap Period Affidavit (available at the university website).
- 7.3 Candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination and should have secured a Pass grade in all subjects.
- 7.4 The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Biology, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship.
- 7.5 The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn based on JEE (Main) 2026 AIR Rank in no other category will be considered.
- 7.6 **CHOICE(S) OF INSTITUTES/BRANCHES** - During counselling the candidate will need to select any one Institute/University and give choice for any/all the programs of that Institute/ University.
- 7.7 **COUNSELLING INTIMATION:**
- Counselling will be based on Merit. Candidates eligible for counselling on a specific date will be informed.
  - Intimation will be sent by Email on registered mail ID's.
  - Ignorance/lapses, if any, in participating in the allotted counselling slot shall not be accepted as an excuse to participate in counselling at a later date.

### 7.8 COUNSELLING

## 9.2 Fees structure for NRI/INTERNATIONAL students:

- (i) The Fee Structure for NRI/International students shall be at par with Fee applicable to Indian students though without applicability of any kind of Scholarship.
- (ii) For NRI students, Fee is required to be paid through NRI's foreign account or NRE account maintained in India & deposited at the time of admission.
- (iii) Fee Conversion in INR will be as per the prevailing rate.
- (iv) Hostel charges (Including Food and Laundry), Caution Money and JYC Charges may be paid in INR equivalent.

## 10. SCHOLARSHIP / FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The following scholarships/ financial assistances are available and only applicable for Indian students admitted to the programs offered by Jaypee University Anoopshahr w.e.f. AY 2025-26.

### 1. TUITION FEE WAIVER FOR DEFENCE, CAPF AND CPO'S WARDS:

- 30% Tuition Fee waiver for the entire period (min duration) of the program for wards of Defence, CAPF and CPO's.
- 35% Tuition Fee waiver for the entire period (min duration) of the program for wards of Defence, CAPF and CPO's personnel who sacrificed their lives for security and safety of the nation.

### 4. CONCESSION IN FEE FOR STUDENTS FROM JAYPEE SCHOOLS ADMITTED TO JAYPEE UNIVERSITY ANOOPSHAHR

- (a) The mentioned concession shall be applicable to the students of Jaypee Schools across Pan India whereas they shall be eligible for award of 10 % of concession in Tuition Fee as applicable to the respective programs/ Batches of their entry.
- (b) The above concession in Fee shall be applicable for 1st year only. The same may be continued in subsequent years (Minimum duration of the program) subject to achieving the minimum CGPA of 6 on a scale of 10 at the end of each academic year.
- (c) The above shall be applicable for the students admitted to Diploma and UG programs only.

### 5. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (PAYMENT OF FEE IN INSTALMENTS):

It has been observed that many of students are not able to pay their fees in advance for the semester whereas Jaypee University believes that money should not be barrier for students to pursue their studies.

Considering above, it is permitted to charge the fee from students (who are not able pay their fee in advance for the semester/year and having parent's income of less than Rs. 2.0 lakh per annum), on monthly basis. However the following criteria/terms & conditions are required to meet for the same:

- (a) The student must approach the University's authority requesting his/her inability to pay full fee in advance and accept the fee payment on monthly basis along with the submission of income certificate as required.
- (b) The payment of fee on monthly basis shall be applicable on Total Fee (except Caution Money and JYC Charges) which shall be divided by 10 and accordingly the fee dues shall be made for the concerned student on monthly basis.

### 6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The student shall be eligible for any one scholarship at a time as given in Section 1 to 4.
- During the first semester, the student shall be required to pay the full fee however scholarship awarded for the first year will be considered/adjusted in the Fee dues for 2nd semester along with the regular scholarship of 1st semester as applicable.

## 11. REFUND POLICY

11.1 The Application Fee is not refundable.

11.2 In case of withdrawal, the Academic Fee shall be refundable as per UGC/AICTE Norms. Last date of admission shall be notified/communicated as per the policy/instructions by regulatory bodies.

11.3 Refund of Hostel Charges:

- Till the date of registration, a candidate is entitled for full refund of advance Hostel Charges, provided the student does not occupy the Hostel in advance.
- From the Date of Registration in the program, the amount shall be refunded on pro-rata monthly basis, even if the student has not occupied the Hostel or not taken the key to the room.
- For calculation of pro-rata charges, the duration of the semester shall be considered as five (5) months and deduction /refund shall be made on per month basis even if the hostel is occupied for part of a month i.e. even for a single day.

## 12. ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the campus. Note that ragging is a criminal offence and punishable act. The Supreme Court of India has also defined ragging as a criminal offence.

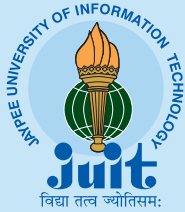

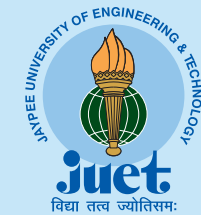
